
Re: Consideration of a Request for a Vacation of Public Right-of-Way at 2 East Mason

Pursuant to authorization given to Mayor Justin Wilson at the City Council public hearing meeting of September 12, 2020, we the undersigned were appointed as viewers to view the public right-of-way property at 2 East Mason.

We have viewed the property and it is the majority opinion (comprised of J. Dechant and M. Wilson) that the vacation and discontinuation of public right-of-way would not cause any inconvenience or harm to the public. One viewer (C.E. Palmer Johnson) found that the discontinuation of public right-of-way *would* cause inconvenience or harm to the public (as indicated in the attached letter). 
