

Talking Points for Charles Sumpter, Candidate for Alexandria Redevelopment and Housing Authority
As of 11 March 2013

- Maintaining affordable, safe, and clean housing for our most vulnerable residents is of personal importance to me.
- Having grown up in New York City public housing, I have seen firsthand how critical safe and decent housing is to a child's development. On the other hand, I have also witnessed families living in units unsafe and not properly maintained, exposing residents to a multitude of risks.
- With budget cuts looming, jurisdictions have to manage more and more with limited resources and Alexandria is no different. Fully supporting the need for Alexandria to grow and maximize its economic base, I would be mindful of the delicate social challenges that would also have to be balanced.
- I come with a critical eye, always asking the necessary questions. According to the Housing Master Plan, Average waiting period for one of ARHA's 1,076 physical housing units is 6-8 years.
 - a. What is the standard in like sized jurisdictions?
 - b. Is this too long of a wait?
- As someone who didn't always drive, I am highly conscious of public transportation in relation to housing units across the city to make Alexandria a more livable and walkable community.
- It is my desire to be among the thought leaders working to develop new and innovative strategies for reshaping what the future of Alexandria's housing market will look like.
