- Designated civilian oversight agency empowered to ensure accountability and public trust in police
- June 2024: City Council Update on Civilian Oversight
- Ad Hoc Work Group to consider changes to enabling ordinances for Fall 2024 Council Consideration
 - Committee included Auditor, Board Members, Police Department, City Attorney and City Manager
 - Community engagement to solicit feedback on proposed changes



Consensus Building

Committee positive & with consensus on almost all items

- Primary areas of focus:
 - Review <u>Board</u> Meeting & Training Requirements
 - Clarification of Review <u>Board</u> and <u>Auditor</u> Roles
 - <u>Auditor</u> Duties & Responsibilities



Themes in Key Proposed Changes to <u>Board</u> Ordinance

- <u>Board</u> would retain authority to review investigations conducted by Auditor/APD & police policies/procedures
- <u>Board</u> would establish a formal inquiry intake process for community concerns about policing
 - Board may request investigations pursuant to identified patterns and practices of potential discrimination, bias, unequal treatment
- <u>Board</u> training, quorum, and meeting requirements and duties amended



Themes in Key Proposed Changes to <u>Auditor</u> Ordinance

Auditor will monitor and/or conduct investigations of incidents

<u>Auditor</u> will engage APD, predominantly marginalized and minority communities and provide periodic reports to City Council, City Manager, Board and APD

Board: Prefers
subpoena power
for Auditor to
enable Board to
carry out scope of
its work

Staff & AIPA: Prefers
text focused on a
Chief's right to compel
officers to comply,
consistent with existing
Garrity Rights
