

Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (MWCOG) Technical Assistance Grants



Transportation Land-Use Connections (TLC) Program provides planning studies and work that promotes mixed-use, walkable communities and transportation alternatives. **Beauregard Street Trail Feasibility Study**



Regional Roadway Safety Program (RRSP) provides planning preliminary engineering to address roadway safety issues to reduce fatal and serious injury crashes. Braddock Road Safety Study


Background Information

- Work to be completed by June 0 30, 2026




Project Locations



Beauregard Street (TLC)


Study feasibility of a multi-use trail on North Beauregard Street between Fillmore Avenue and Fairfax County

Study safety improvements on Braddock Road between Quaker Lane and Van Dorn Street




