Statement of Interest
The City of Alexandria’s decarbonizing and energy efficiency efforts remain lagging. For example, far less than 1% of residential units are powered by solar, a problem exacerbated by the fact the city still permits natural gas heating for a humid, subtropical climate zone. Our residence, the Venue Townhomes completed in 2022, was built with gas furnaces likely in part because state electricity generation remains dominated by natural gas. Concerning the business community, for example, none of Alexandria’s three INOVA hospitals have ever been Energy Star certified. Healthcare is grossly energy inefficient, it’s carbon footprint exceeds 600 MMT of CO2e annually, and GHG emissions disproportionately harm seniors, children and minoritized populations more generally. I began my career doing environmental policy research concerning, e.g., The Navajo Generation Station’s SOx and NOx emissions and over the past several years my work has entirely focused on climate-related healthcare policy. (Anthropogenic warming is at least from an anthropocentric perspective fundamentally and human health/extinction problem).
