Dear Ms. Hamer,

The Del Ray Citizens Association Land Use Committee and Executive Board discussed this Development Site Plan application involving the redevelopment of the site of the current Afghan Restaurant.

The developer has proposed to tear down the existing building and build a new building with retail along Route 1 and parking in the rear. After an initial presentation to the Land Use Committee in August, the developer made several changes to the design, the revised version of which was presented to the Committee at our September 12, 2013 meeting.

The Land Use Committee was very pleased overall with the redesign and the applicant's considerable effort to address concerns raised by the Land Use Committee in August. The Committee voted to support the DSP application with the recommendation that the developer consider making a few minor changes to the architectural details of the design. These suggestions are set forth in detail in the attached document and include recommendations to: switch to linear canopies that make the retail areas more visible (potentially in metal and keeping in line with the industrial architecture of the building); raise the parapets on the ends and in the center slightly; use precast stone trim similar to other similarly styled buildings in Del Ray, such as those along Leslie and Monroe Avenues; switch to less detail in the brickwork in the rear of the building (painted CMU wall, less trim, e.g.) but consider incorporating murals in the future as are seen along the stores on Mt. Vernon Avenue (Cheesetique, Mancini's, etc.). The suggested architectural changes are described in greater detail in the attached document.




