I'm writing to express my complete opposition to a proposal city staff is selling as a 'compromise plan' (Concept 2) for the King Street bike lanes. I oppose this 'compromise' because 1) it will do nothing to encourage the young, or more risk averse bicyclists to ride and 2) Concept 2 perverts the core transportation hierarchy that city staff and city council claim to support, which is: pedestrians first, followed by transit, bicyclists and lastly cars.

Unlike Concept 1, what this 'compromise' does is to put cyclists in danger – forcing them to swerve out of a safe bike lane into traffic - just to accommodate a few parked cars for residents that already have private driveways. Twisting the order of the last two categories of Alexandria's transportation hierarchy.

Is it OK to put cyclists in danger just so a few parked cars can block a public road? No way! Not when there is a better safer and more inclusive choice – Concept 1.

So what kind of compromise is this Concept 2? This compromise puts humans below parked cars, that's why this compromise needs to go into the trash bin.

Concept 2's sharrows are a false and dangerous compromise:

1. Virginia state law says bicyclists are allowed to use any and all city streets. Sharrows are just a reminder to drivers, and just like the like the speed limit reminders on signs on King St. they will be regularly ignored. Sharrows mean nothing to motorists and offer no protection to bicyclists on this busy street.
2. Sharrows by definition require mixing bicyclists and cars. No biking parent towing a child or a teenager biking to school will want to put themselves into the middle of a busy arterial like King St.
3. This city already has plenty of sharrows throughout the city, yet there's been no appreciable change in the demographic of the bicyclist. It is still mostly experienced 'ninja class' male bicyclists wearing black tights willing to mix with traffic when needed. Without a complete bike lane network, this demographic will never change.

A Space for ALL Cyclists:

After City Staff's presentation of the 'compromise' plan, there were a lot of unhappy people in the room on both sides of this issue. But what got trampled in all the emotional cacophony were just two voices, one of a father, Peter W. that takes his child to pre school in a bike trailer, and another from a mother Natasha A. that likes to ride to work - both said that they will not ride on King unless there are bike lanes.

City staff, the Traffic and Parking Board and City Council, please keep cyclists safe. You have the power to do

this so we need your leadership to deliver needed changes to Alexandria's bicycling facilities to accommodate all cyclists - the young, seniors, and parents towing children – not just ninjas. Please trash Concept 2 and paint Concept 1 on King Street now!

Do not cower to the greedy noise made by the car first crowd - they have their driveways. Keep your word on the transportation hierarchy and deliver it!

Ms. Poole,

We spoke briefly on the phone Mon, Sept 23, 2013.

Following are my concerns about the Proposed King Street Bicycle Lanes Project (Russell Road to Janneys Lane):

- This is a high density traffic area with a great deal of large-vehicle traffic (buses and trucks) and is unsafe for cyclists at any speed
- Vehicles (cars, buses, trucks) traverse this stretch of roadway and move to the left when turning left (when possible) so other vehicles can pass on the right and keep traffic flowing. This is also unsafe for cyclists.
- It is almost impossible to speed on this stretch of roadway due to traffic congestion
- Residents along this stretch of King St. do not all have off-street parking; therefore, they would be forced to park in other locations sometimes well away from their homes. This would also be a hazard on such a congested artery. (why would the City make Seminary Road such a neighborhood friendly roadway (by adding off-street parking), while at the same time adding the barriers and jut-outs that are also "accidents waiting to happen" on such a well-traveled roadway.

Observations of bicycle riders – just a couple of examples of things I see every day:

Mon, Sept 23 at 6:15 a.m. on Callahan Street, by Union Station, Alexandria, VA: This was at a time of day when it was still dark. A cyclist with no lights on his bike, no reflective material, and wearing all dark clothing, rode his bike across Callahan about 50 ft. away from the crosswalk, cycling from the Masonic Temple Roadway across Callahan onto the sidewalk on the opposite side of Callahan, without even appearing to look left or right. Given the vehicular traffic, even at that hour of the morning, this was highly dangerous.

Sat, Sept 21, at 4:15 p.m. on Kenwood between King Street and Fern Street, heading toward Lindsay Cadillac, a cyclist went through the stop sign at Osage, then wove in and out of the traffic lane (sometimes in the middle of the street/sometimes to the right of the traffic lane), not giving any directional signals whenever a lane change was made.

Cyclists should have to observe traffic laws (or some systemized bicycle rules); have to obtain cycling licenses (just as drivers have to obtain driver's licenses); and be made to observe the helmet rules if they are going to be sharing the road with other drivers. This isn't to say vehicle drivers are without fault.

As a city, we should consider all: drivers of vehicles AND cyclists. Consideration should be given to using side streets, which in many cases have less traffic, rather than using major thoroughfares, for cyclists' use. Consideration should also be given to using one-way side streets for cyclists as these would also be safer, or even adding one-way traffic flow rather than using two-way. Using streets such as King Street, Janney's Lane, and similar major roadways for cyclists is "an accident waiting to happen."

I'm quite certain the City has already decided to add the bicycle lanes, however, this is being sent notwithstanding. This will also be sent to the City Council members even though my experience with contacting them has been they rarely respond.

I am writing at the suggestion of Jim Durham in support of the City's proposal to calm traffic on King Street. I live a few streets behind the area (Putnam Place) and have all but stopped using that area as a pedestrian. As I previously shared with Mr. Durham, these have been my experiences and thus, my concerns:

1. Traffic speed on King Street. The cars speed ridiculously on King Street. Given that most of the sidewalks are directly next to the vehicle traffic (with no grass median/separation between the sidewalk and the street), the curbs are quite low, and the residential bushes/greenery on the East side of King Street are rarely trimmed back to leave sufficient walking space with a stroller, it feels as if you are running a gauntlet when walking that area. It is terrifying to have cars rushing by even at 25 MPH when you have little ones in a stroller.

2. Crossing King Street. It is wonderful to have a light at Highland, however, there are no sidewalks on a good portion of Highland leading up to the light, so it is somewhat pointless to have the light there. I was walking one of my children in a stroller up to the light, having to walk in the street since there are no sidewalks and was nearly hit by an oncoming vehicle that was turning off of King Street onto Highland. The shrubs on the corner lots are high and block everyone's view. And, there is no light or easy crossing at Upland.

Because of these first two items, I have stopped walking on King Street with my kids and we now drive down to the train station to watch the trains and Old Town. Pretty ridiculous!

3. Passing cars on King Street. When I'm driving up King Street to turn left onto Upland into our neighborhood, cars (even a Dash bus) pass on the right at full speed. Right next to the sidewalk; where there is barely enough room.

Suffice it to say, I'm all for some sort of traffic calming, narrowing the lanes to include bicycle lanes, etc. It's a shame that King Street is so dangerous from a pedestrian and biker standpoint. Also, I don't know who specifically is concerned about the loss of parking spaces along King Street, but I find that rather amusing considering that most of the houses on the West side of King Street don't even shovel their sidewalks during snowstorms. I am reminded of the large snow storm 4 years ago where my neighbor (with Parkinson's, no less) tried to organize a neighborhood snow shoveling party to shovel the sidewalks along King Street so he could walk to the Metro.

I am not against bike lanes in general - I like them throughout the city, but I feel that King street is too narrow of a street to support the dedicated lanes.

I see streets throughout Alexandria that are much wider than King and those streets have "sharrows" instead of dedicated lanes. Parts of Commonwealth Avenue and Braddock Road for example. So I'm not clear what determines the placement of "sharrow" vs. a bike lane.

-I believe that the proposed bike lanes will be a hardship for the residents that live along King St.
-the homes on King St were not built with much "off street" parking, if any at all. They may have a very small parking pad, but not a real driveway or parking place.
-The current parking lane aids these residents in backing out of their driveways.
-the residents are not all able to walk a block or more to get to/fr their cars if they park in the adjoining neighborhood.

-The adjoining neighborhood streets are already full with resident parking. Many of the homes do not have driveways or off street parking and must park on the street. And the streets in the neighborhood are very narrow and parking additional cars will compound the problem in the neighborhood.

-Bike lanes will make it difficult for repairmen, delivery people, movers, trash collection, etc. to park on the street and service the homes on King St.
Currently UPS trucks and moving trucks park on portions of the sidewalk and they still impede traffic flow along King Street. Making the space available to them smaller will have a much greater impact on traffic. It will effect both East bound and West bound traffic instead of the current impact to only West bound traffic.

-I believe that bike lanes will slow down response times for emergency vehicles that need to use King St. to get through the City. Currently emergency vehicles can get by on King St. because the West bound traffic can move over into the parking lane (and around parked cars). By adding the bike lanes it will be narrowing the street even more and will make it so both West bound and East bound traffic will have to move all the way into the bike lane and to the curb so that there is a lane in the middle for the emergency vehicle. This doesn't seem like a realistic or safe way to get emergency vehicles along King St.

These are just a few of the reasons I am against the proposed bike lanes on King St.

Hi Hillary - thank you for your presentation tonight on the proposal for traffic calming and bike lanes on King Street. It's a tough issue people obviously feel very passionately about.

I live on Hilltop Terrace and am I'm an avid biker, I commute to DC using a portion of King Street twice weekly. I also use the full hill leading up to Highland when going on more recreational rides. On most rides I use Walnut as a final challenge on my way home which pops me out on King for a couple blocks as I head home. I have to admit that I've fallen down after coming to a full stop waiting behind a parked car for an opening in the traffic so I can proceed westbound. I was fortunate not to have ended up in the traffic lane. I've also seen cars rear end each other while paying more attention to me than the vehicle ahead of them.

On days I don't bike commute I use a razor scooter to zip down the hill to the metro. Usually in the parking lanes against traffic, then on the sidewalk. On rainy days I walk down the sidewalk like a normal person. And I often ride the bus three stops back up the hill after a long day.

Meanwhile, our family has a student at Jefferson Houston elementary, so we make the trip there by car twice a day.

So we use King Street a lot. And there's no doubt it's a very dangerous area where street width, speeds, signage visibility and a diverse mix of users come together.

I agree with your parking survey, that the parking lanes are not used regularly, especially during the day. But I feel they are needed and it is fair to the adjacent residents on both sides of the street that they be kept. I agree with their need for parking, pull out space, garbage can space, delivery space, etc. I also agree that the parked cars play a key role in traffic calming. I noticed it even tonight on the way back from the meeting.

I would love to see a light put in at the crossings you mentioned. I think that will make things much better. I disagree with the proposal mentioned that the stop light be moved from Highland to Upland. If anything, one should be added at Upland. Making left turns onto King Street from both and a right turn at Highland is always treacherous due to the limited visibility and red light violations.

While I don't expect all bikers to ride down King Street at 25mph, I think we would all be better served to raise visibility of the fact that these lanes should be shared, that the speed limit is 25mph, and that this is a residential street.

I think opening/reconnecting Walnut and King would be dangerous for everyone, even though it could/might really help ease the insane backups heading down hill during rush hour morning and night. My contention has always been that a traffic circle at Russell/King/Callahan would be best, but that could backfire with stop light backups on the other side of the rails.

In the interest of completely burying the lead here, the ideal configuration for me would be hybrid bike/parking lanes going uphill so cars know to be on the lookout for bikes and give them the right of way when they are present. A hybrid bike/car lane heading downhill would have a similar effect.

I don't think adding bike lanes will add much more bike traffic to King Street. It's a challenging hill that is well-served by many bus routes. But for those of us who want to ride it, increasing awareness of the potential presence of cyclists would help us feel safer when dodging trash cans and cars. I think it works well on Commonwealth, it would work on King as well.

The idea that simply displacing parked cars from King Street to the neighborhood does not set well with me. It is difficult enough for residents on the adjacent streets to find parking at night and I don't feel it will attract more bike users. The car lanes are used more during dark hours when bikers are less likely to need the lanes.

I am a huge proponent of bike lanes, I think Alexandria is making great progress toward making the city more usable, but I think the plan as it stands now is overreaching. However, a compromise should be in reach to make almost everyone happy.

Dear Sir or Madam

I use to live with relatives in one of the homes which back against King Street. I love the idea of bike lanes and always used the backyard entrance onto King Street to go biking.

The parking along that street is hardly ever used. However, many homes do use the spaces occasionally to load and unload materials into backyards because due to the hill, it is difficult to do so in the front of the home. An exemption to parking in a bike lane for loading and unloading only would placate many residents' concerns. All this would take are a few signs explaining the exemption and some education at the enforcement level.

Also, while this section of King Street not easy to bike on, the most dangerous section is just after where the bike lane ends, at the intersection of Russell Road and King Street. It would be greatly beneficial both the drivers and cyclists to continue the lane through this intersection to the Metro station as a number of residents use bicycles to get to the Metro station. Eliminating the left hand turning lane and removing the ban on turning left onto West Rosemont would be a better use of city resources because hardly anyone turns left at the intersection, even during rush hour, and even from a traffic standpoint, a quick left turn before the intersection would ease the flow of traffic.

I have been working with the city on bike and pedestrian issues since 1999. The Washington region as well as the city is growing which brings more people and traffic. We must effectively use all modes of transportation to address this problem. King Street is the primary NW/SE corridor for vehicles and cyclists in the city. However this corridor continues to be a safety problem for cyclists as is evident to any of you who have driven or biked along this street. These proposed bike lanes will increase safety for cyclists and therefore increase the bike traffic along the corridor. 




