Title

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 2-2-11 (ESTABLISHMENT OF CENTRAL ABSENTEE VOTER ELECTION DISTRICT AND VOTING PLACE) by adding Charles E. Beatley, Jr. Central Library as an additional absentee voting place for November elections.

Summary

The proposed ordinance adds The Charles E. Beatley, Jr. Central Library as an additional permanent absentee voting place for November elections. Currently, the City has only one permanent absentee voting place located at 132North Royal Street, Alexandria, Virginia. The current location serves as a permanent absentee voting place for all elections while the new location will serve as a permanent absentee voting place for November elections only.
