RESOLUTION TO CONVERT A TWO-WAY SEGMENT OF THE KING STREET ACCESS ROAD TO ONE-WAY OPERATION

WHEREAS, under Section 2.04(g) of the City Charter, City Council has the authority to regulate the operation of motor and other vehicles in the streets of the city; and

WHEREAS, City Council has adopted Complete Streets and Vision Zero policies that directs staff to prioritize safe, comfortable, and convenient multimodal access and mobility on city-owned streets; and

WHEREAS, at the June 2024 meeting of the Traffic and Parking Board members unanimously approved a recommendation pursuant to City Code Section 5-8-3(g)(3) to convert the King Street Access Road from South Taylor Street to Menokin Drive to one-way westbound operation to facilitate safer traffic operations, improved opportunities for cyclists and pedestrians, and multimodal accessibility improvements as part of the King Street-Bradlee Safety and Mobility Enhancements Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

That, as part of the improvements for the planned safety, mobility and accessibility improvements planned and designed as part of the King Street-Bradlee Safety and Mobility Enhancements Project, the operation of the King Street Access Road from South Taylor Street to Menokin Drive shall be converted to one-way westbound operation.
