Interests & Experiences

When I first applied to the Traffic and Parking Board, I emphasized that I wanted to join the Board in order to make the City safer for all road users. I have done that. In my time on the Board, we have approved City plans for pedestrian safety measures on Commonwealth Avenue in Rosemont and to reduce the speed limit on Seminary Road west of I-395. We have removed numerous parking spaces for one safety issue or another (as well as to add Bikeshare stations) and insisted on an all-way stop at Helen and Leadbeater Streets, a tucked-away intersection off Mount Vernon Avenue with sight-line problems. My presence on the board provides another voice for the interests of pedestrians, cyclists, and transit users. Our streets and parking are public resources and should be managed as such, for the safety, accessibility, and benefit of everyone. I would like to continue as part of a body that helps to facilitate multimodal, convenient transport for everyone, which in turn will help to address congestion; according to the Alexandria Mobility Plan, 71 percent of outreach respondents named congestion the number one challenge for the future of mobility in the City. The Mobility Plan, like other City plans, informs the work of the Traffic and Parking Board. It is important that the City's decisions, including those of boards and commissions, are consistent with applicable plans. The comprehensive nature of plans, and the extensive public process undertaken to create them, should drive individual on-the-ground actions and streamline any associated approval process. I am a former president of the Del Ray Citizens Association and member of its Land Use Committee (if reappointed, I would continue to be the only Del Ray resident on the board) and oversee environmental planning and analysis for a federal agency. I have experience in public involvement, including in receiving public comments and meaningfully considering them, regardless of the emotional investment (or not) of the person providing the comment. As a public servant, I respect the work of City staff and understand the challenge they face in trying to please many different stakeholders. Yet the role of the board is to consider City proposals critically and not necessarily to rubber stamp them, and my history on the Board demonstrates that I walk this line well. Certain issues are likely to come before the Traffic and Parking Board in the next year, including management of cut-through traffic, additional speed limit reductions around the City, and Vision Zero implementation, all on top of worthwhile endeavors like updating a given location's parking restrictions to be consistent with current use or need. I remain the right person to provide a citizen's perspective on these issues. I have lived in Alexandria for a long time and have walked, biked, bussed, and driven all over this city. Moreover, I am focused on its future, on making it a place where everyone can get around safely, regardless of ability, budget, or car ownership.

See resume for work experience. 2020-2022: Traffic and Parking Board - As a member of the Traffic and Parking Board, I have analyzed the information presented by the City and citizens, visited the locations of certain docket items in order to better understand an issue's context, and voted repeatedly in favor of making Alexandria a safer place for all road users. 2019-2021: Past President, Del Ray Citizens Association - As the past president, which is a board position, I provided guidance to the president and the rest of the board to ensure the smooth running of the organization and maintenance of relationships with community members. I was also the DRCA emissary to the Alexandria Federation of Civic Associations. 2018-2019: President, Del Ray Citizens Association - As president, I established relationships with Del Ray community members, represented Del Ray's position in issues before the City, organized community events, arranged for timely presentations on local issues at meetings, and strove to make Del Ray an even better place to live. 2017-2018: Vice President, Del Ray Citizens Association - As vice president. I conducted meetings and other business in the absence of the president. 2017-present: Member (and co-chair from 2017-2018), Del Ray Citizens Association Land Use Committee -The Land Use Committee handles mostly innocuous residential issues but occasionally very controversial commercial ones. As co-chair and then again as Association president, I served in a leadership role on the meetings for and recommendations regarding several controversial cases, including two beer gardens and a day shelter for people experiencing homelessness (which later became a volunteer organization center). I (and the rest of the Committee) heard the often very angry comments from the public, listened to the applicants and worked with them to modify their plans to something more palatable that nevertheless served their needs, and drafted recommendations to the Planning Commission and City Council.
