Item #3 – Amendment to By-laws

A revision to the Alexandria Transit Company By-Laws is proposed for consideration.

Draft Revisions are as follows as approved and proposed by the ATC Board of Directors:

ARTICLE 2, Section 1:

Directors need not be stockholders, and shall be comprised of the following:

- a. The City Manager or designee;
- b. The City's Chief Financial Officer or designee;
- c. The City's Transportation and Environmental Services (T&ES) Director or designee;
- d. A City resident with transportation experience;
- e. ~~A City resident with financial experience; and~~
- f. A minimum of five (5), maximum of seven (7) additional riders or City residents who are not employees of the City, Alexandria Transit Company, or any subsidiary thereof.

One member of the Board of Directors who is not a City of Alexandria employee shall also serve as a representative to the Alexandria Transportation Commission.


Item #4 – Outside Auditor

Consideration of Approval:

By agreement with the City of Alexandria, ATC accounts are maintained by the City's Department of Finance and are audited as a part of the City's annual audit. If the City's outside auditor is also ATC's outside auditor, the ATC audit can be done without duplication of effort or cost. It is therefore recommended that the City's outside auditor be designated ATC's outside auditor.
