INFORMATION ON PROPOSED ORDINANCE

Title

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 2-2-13 (MAP OF ELECTION DISTRICTS AND VOTING PLACES), to amend and reordain “The Official Map of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, Designating Election Districts and Voting Places,” adopted by Section 2-2-13 (MAP OF ELECTION DISTRICTS AND VOTING PLACES), all of Chapter 2 (ELECTIONS), Title 2 (GENERAL GOVERNMENT) of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended.

Summary

The proposed ordinance implements changes in two precinct boundaries, impacting four precincts, to conform the precincts lines with the new House of Delegates district lines from the 2020 redistricting process.

Estimated Costs of Implementation

If City Council and the Office of the Attorney General approve this ordinance, The Electoral Board will send new voter cards by first class mail to all affected voters which will cost approximately \$90,000. All voters will receive a new voter card as the state has moved portions of the City into a new Senate and House of Delegates districts. Funds have been budgeted in the contingent reserve for this purpose. Additionally, voters whose precincts have changed, would be sent a second mailing prior to the November General election. This mailing would cost approximately \$600 and can be accommodated within the budget of the Office of Voter Registration & Elections.
