All voters will receive a new voter card as the state has 42 moved portions of the City into a new Senate and House of Delegates districts. Funds have been budgeted in the contingent reserve for this purpose. Additionally, voters whose 43 precincts have changed, would be sent a second mailing prior to the November General 44 45 election.
