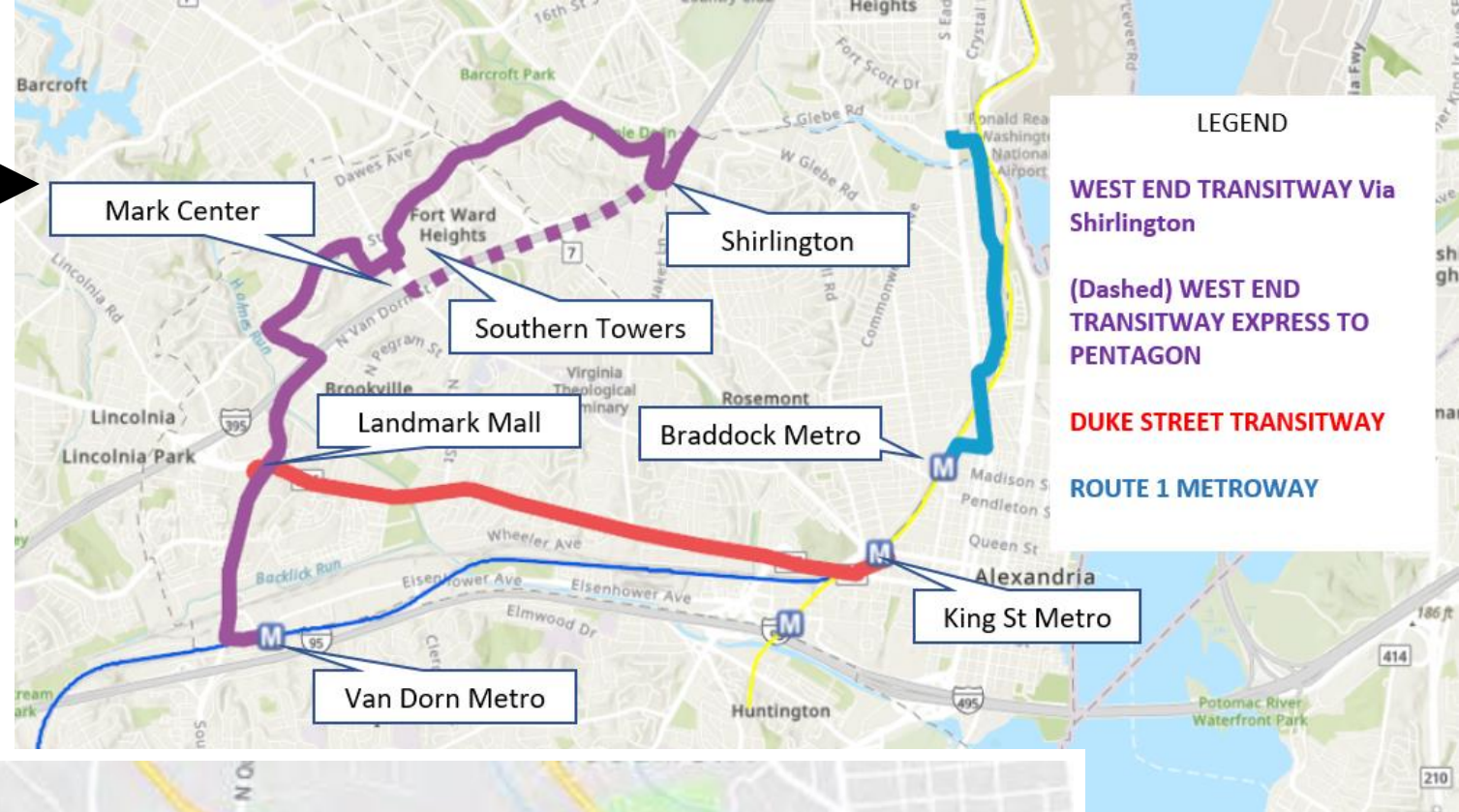


Transitway Background

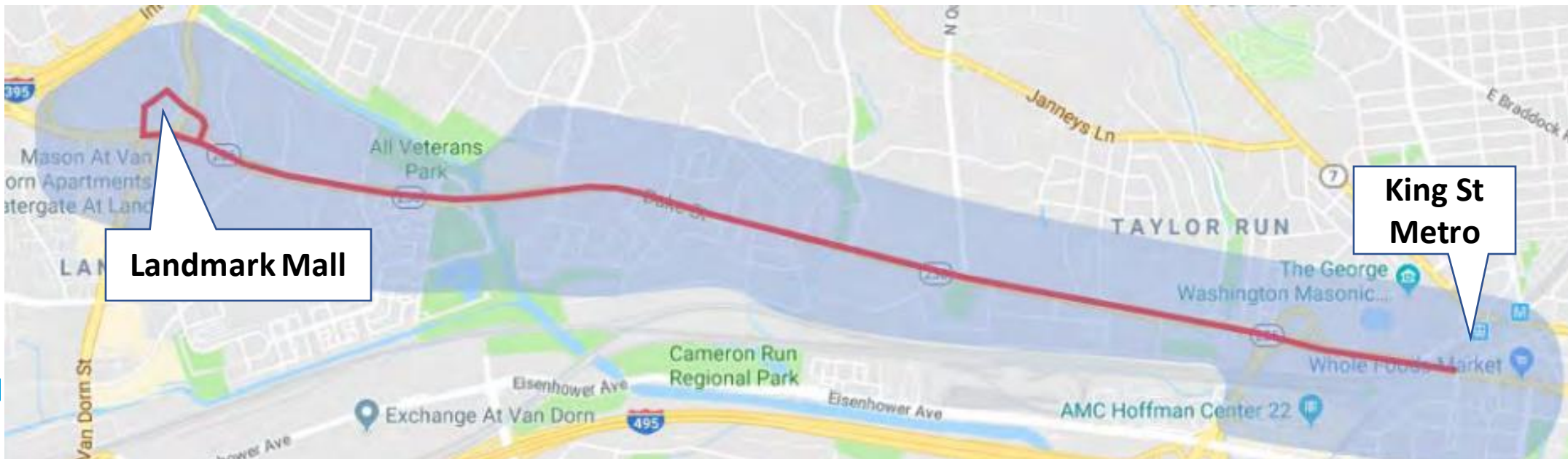
- Adopted in:
 - 2008 Transportation Master Plan
 - 2012 Transitway Feasibility Study
 - 2020 Transit Vision Plan
 - 2021 Alexandria Mobility Plan
- Duke Street In Motion project kick-off in summer 2021
 - 1,800 feedback form responses
 - 23 pop-up events along the corridor
 - Project kick-off webinar with approximately 100 live viewers
 - Feedback used to develop design Vision and Guiding Principles
- Corridor design concepts development, refinement, and selection of Preferred Alternative task to be completed Spring 2022-Spring 2023

Advisory Group Proposed Composition

9 members

- Transportation Commission member (1)
- Planning Commission member (1)
- Alexandria Commission on Persons with Disabilities member or designee (1)
- DASH Bus Riders Group member or designee (1)
- Federation of Civic Association member or designee (1)
- At-large community representatives (3)
- Representative of the development community (1)

At large community members will represent interests unique to this project such as students, renters, businesses, minority communities, and non-driving households.



Advisory Group Roles and Responsibilities

Tasks

- Represent the perspectives of their representative constituencies and communicate back to their respective groups;
- Adopt the project's Vision and Guiding Principles;
- Provide comments and recommendations for corridor design alternatives;
- Recommend to Council to either adopt or amend the 2012 Transit Corridors Feasibility Plan; and
- Endorsement of preferred alternative

Duration: One Year with potential to extend up to 12 months

- 1) Approve the attached resolution establishing an Ad Hoc Duke Street Transitway Advisory Group
- 2) Authorize the City Manager to appoint the 3 at-large and 1 development community representatives.
