Despite the new category of infraction and consistent enforcement 24 from Police, heavy vehicle parking remains an issue so City residents and business owners 25 have continued submitting numerous related complaints to City staff. At the January 11, 26 2022, City Council meeting, the City Council requested Staff to develop enforcement 27 options on the topic of commercial truck fines.
