6	amended, to amend and reordain Section 12-1-4 (ELECTION OF SCHOOL BOARD
7	MEMBERS; DATE AND MANNER OF ELECTION), all of Chapter 1 (SCHOOL DISTRICT
8	AND SCHOOL BOARD), Title 12 (EDUCATION, SOCIAL SERVICES AND WELFARE) of
9	The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, and to amend and reordain
10	"The Official Map of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, Designating Election Districts and Voting
11	Places," adopted by Section 2-2-13 (MAP OF ELECTION DISTRICTS AND VOTING
12	PLACES), all of Chapter 2 (ELECTIONS), Title 2 (GENERAL GOVERNMENT) of The Code
13 14	of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended.
14	THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:
16	THE CIT I COULCEE OF ALEXANDRIA HERED FORDALIOS.
17	Section 1. That Section 2-2-10 Subsection (z) of The Code of the City of Alexandria,
18	Virginia, 1981, as amended, be, and the same hereby is, amended and reordained to delete the
19	text shown in strikethrough and add the text shown in underline as follows:
20	
21	(z) The St. James Church Election District shall henceforth be known as The Hermitage
22	Election District shall henceforth by known as the Ferdinand T. Day School Election District and
23	be bounded and described by the census blocks shown on the map adopted by section 2-2-13 of
24 25	this Code as comprising the said district.
25 26	The voting place within the Hermitage Election District F. T. Day School Election District shall be at the HermitageFerdinand T. Day School, located at 5000 Fairbanks
20 27	<u>Avenue</u> 1701 North Beauregard Street.
28	Avenue <u>1701 North Deauregard Street</u> .
29	Section 2. That Section 12-1-4 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as
30	amended, be, and the same hereby is, amended and reordained to delete the text shown in
31	strikethrough and add the text shown in underline as follows:
32	
33	(a) The election of all nine school board members shall be held on the day of the
34	November 2024 general election first Tuesday in May, beginning in May 1994, and on the day of
35	the November general election every third year thereafter.
36 37	(b) The nine members of the school board shall be cleated in accordance with subscription
37 38	(b) The nine members of the school board shall be elected, in accordance with subsection (c), by the qualified voters residing in the school board election districts. To be eligible to be a
38 39	candidate for election from a school board election district, an individual must be a resident of
40	the district.
41	
42	(c) The city shall be divided into three school board election districts, District A, District
43	B and District C. Three school board members shall be elected from and shall represent each
44	such district. The three districts shall be composed of the following precincts (or, as identified
45	in <u>title 2</u> of this code, "election districts") located within the city, the boundaries of which are
46	described in section 2-2-10.

1	(i) District A shall be composed of the Lyles Crouch School, City Hall, Ladrey Senior
2	Building, Jefferson Houston School, Fire Department Headquarters, Lee Center, George
3	Washington Middle School, Cora Kelly - "Chick" Armstrong Center, and Mt. Vernon
4	Recreation Center, Durant Center, Charles Houston, and Potomac Yard precincts;
5	(ii) District B shall be composed of the Maury Naomi L. Brooks School, George Mason
6	School, Agudas Achim Congregation, Blessed Sacrament Church, Second Presbyterian Church,
7	Minnie Howard School, Temple Beth El, Northern Virginia Community College Arts Center,
8	Charles Barrett Center, Douglas MacArthur School, Chinquapin Park Recreation Center,
9	Ferdinand T. Day School, AlexRenew, and James K. Polk School precincts; and
10	(iii) District C shall be composed of the Patrick Henry SchoolRecreation Center, Samuel
11	Tucker School, Charles E. Beatley, Jr., Central Library, John Adams School, William Ramsey
12	Ramsay Recreation Center, Cameron Station Community Center, Olympus Condo, and South
13	Port precincts.
14	(d) The boundaries between District A, District B and District C established by the
15	precincts as constituted on March 12, 2022 shall not be changed or amended by subsequent
16	changes or amendments to the precincts, unless expressly provided in the ordinance adopting
17	such changes or amendments to the precincts. (Ord. No. 3693, 12/16/93, Sec. 1; Ord. No. 3796,
18	5/13/95, Sec. 1; Ord. No. 4263, 6/25/02, Sec. 1; Ord. No. 5351, 6/19/21, Sec. 2)
19	
20	Section 3. That "The Official Map of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, Designating
21	Election Districts and Voting Places," adopted by Section 2-2-13 of the Code of the City of
22	Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be, and the same hereby is, amended and reordained as
23	shown on Exhibit 1, attached hereto and incorporated fully by reference.
24	
25	Section 4. That this ordinance shall become effective upon the earlier of i) receipt by the
26	City Attorney's Office of a Certification of No Objection by the Office of the Attorney General
27	of Virginia or ii) May 16, 2022, and the adjustments contained herein will be utilized for the
28	elections in 2022 and thereafter until or unless further modified and amended.
