RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT APPLICATIONS FOR METROPOLITAN WASHINGTON COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS REGIONAL ROADWAY SAFETY PROGRAM FOR FY 2023

WHEREAS, the Regional Roadway Safety Program is administered by the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments; and

WHEREAS, the Roadway Safety Program is intended to fund short-term consultant services to member jurisdictions or agencies to assist with planning or preliminary engineering projects that address roadway safety issues; and

WHEREAS, the Roadway Safety Program provides up to \$80,000 in consultant assistance for design projects; and

WHEREAS, the Alexandria City Council adopted the Alexandria Mobility Plan in 2021, which aims to improve mobility, access, safety, and convenience for all road users; and

WHEREAS, the Alexandria City Council adopted the Vision Zero Policy and Action Plan in 2017, which include a goal to eliminate fatal and severe injury crashes by 2028; and

WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria has identified the intersections of South Patrick Street and Duke Street, and South Henry Street and Duke Street, as high-crash intersections; and

WHEREAS, the Alexandria City Council desires to submit an application to the Regional Roadway Safety Program for up to \$80,000 for Fiscal Year 2023 for Route 1 and Duke Street Intersection Improvements.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Alexandria hereby supports the application for up to \$80,000 from the Regional Roadway Safety Program from the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments for Fiscal Year 2023.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Alexandria City Council hereby grants authority to the City Manager to apply for these grant funds and enter into any necessary agreements with the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments to accept this grant.
