30	Commission.

32	(b) The commission shall consist of 15 members to be appointed by the city council. The		
33	composition of the commission shall be as follows:

13	for a term of four years; provided, that the members of the commission in office as of January			
14	21, 1995, shall continue to serve the unexpired portion of their term of office; and, provided			
15	further, that the members who are the representative of an organization shall cease to be a			
16	member at such time as they shall cease to be a member, in good standing, of the organization			
17	for which they serve as representative.
