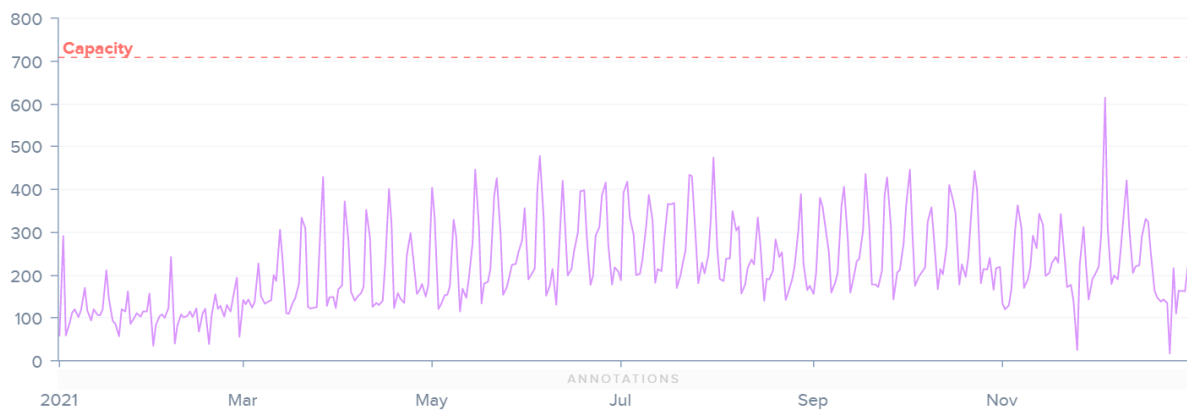


Attachment 5: Examples of Parking Occupancy and Revenue Data

Key Findings:

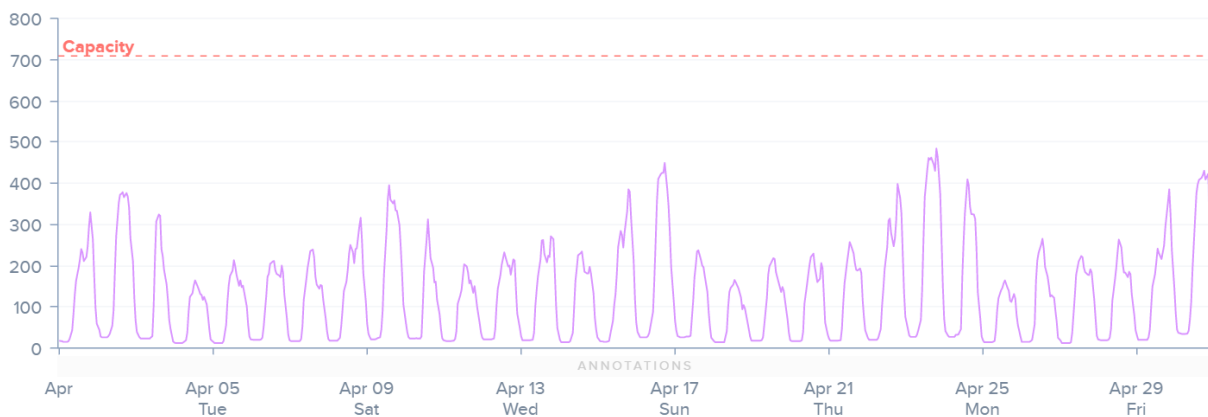
- Aside from very specific special events, there is capacity in our City garages.
 - N. Union Street and Market Square tend to get fuller in the afternoon and evening on Saturdays
 - There is a lot of capacity at the Courthouse Garages in the evening and on weekends
- Patrons tend to park between 2-4 hours in the garage
- Residential Pay by Phone blocks closest to the Waterfront have higher volumes

CY 2021 Garage Occupancy – All Garages



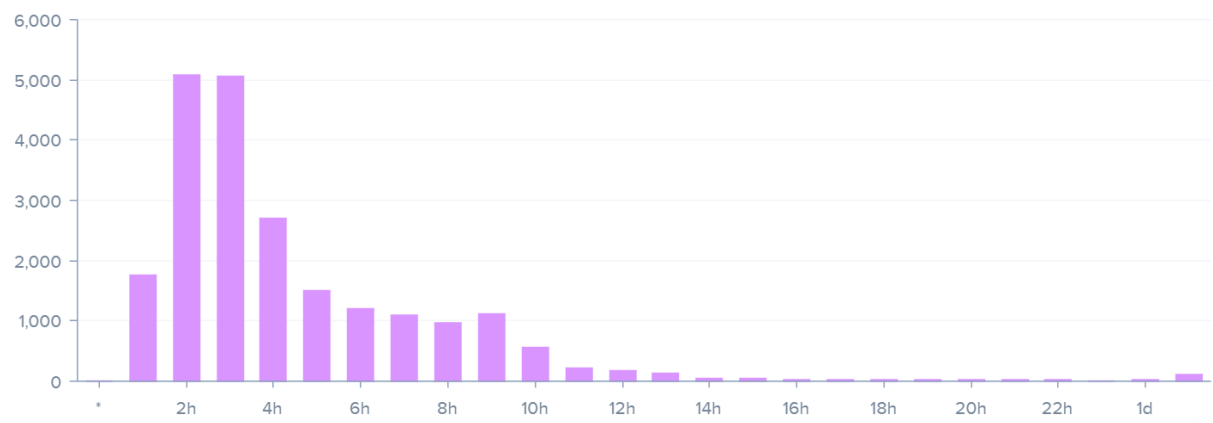
Note: Spike in December is Dec 4 – weekend of Scottish Walk and Boat Parade; Dips in November and December are Thanksgiving and Christmas

April 2022 Garage Occupancy – All Garages

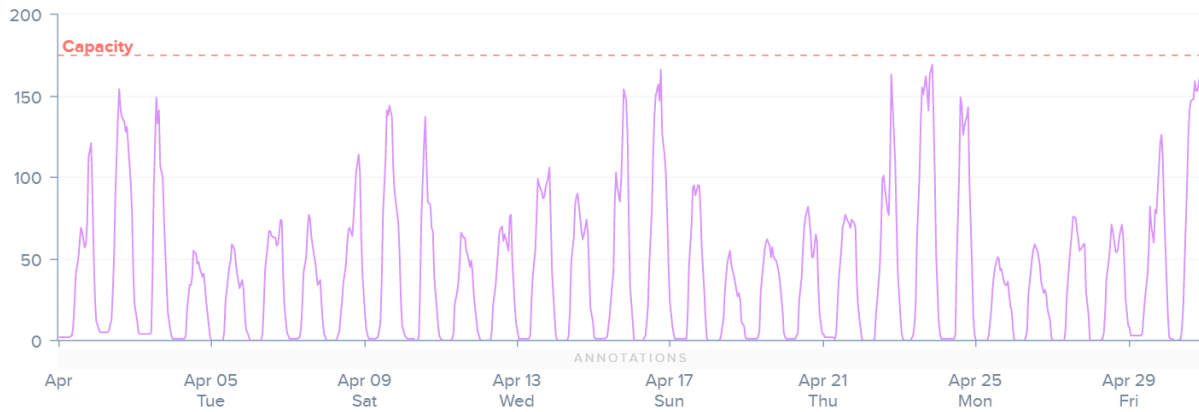


Note: typically, two peaks each date – first around 1-2 pm, second around 6 pm

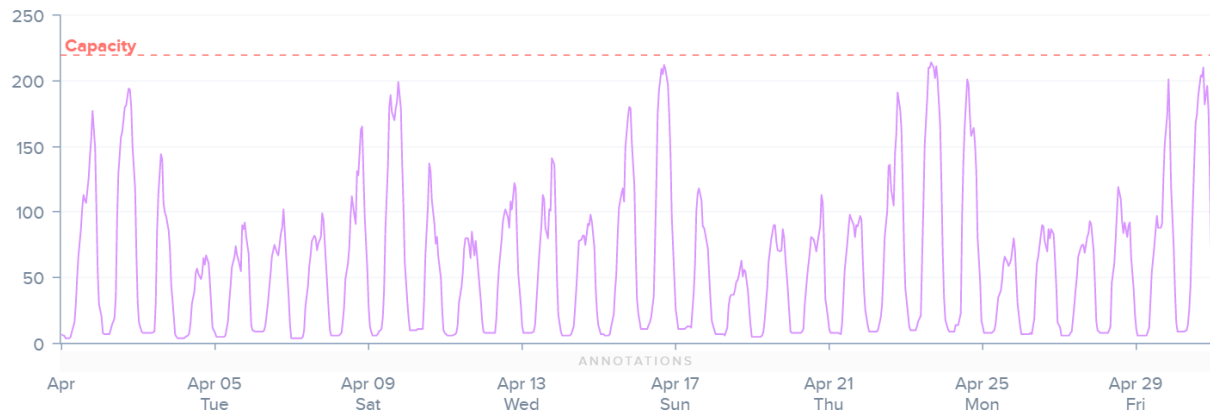
April 2022 Transient Parking Duration – All Garages



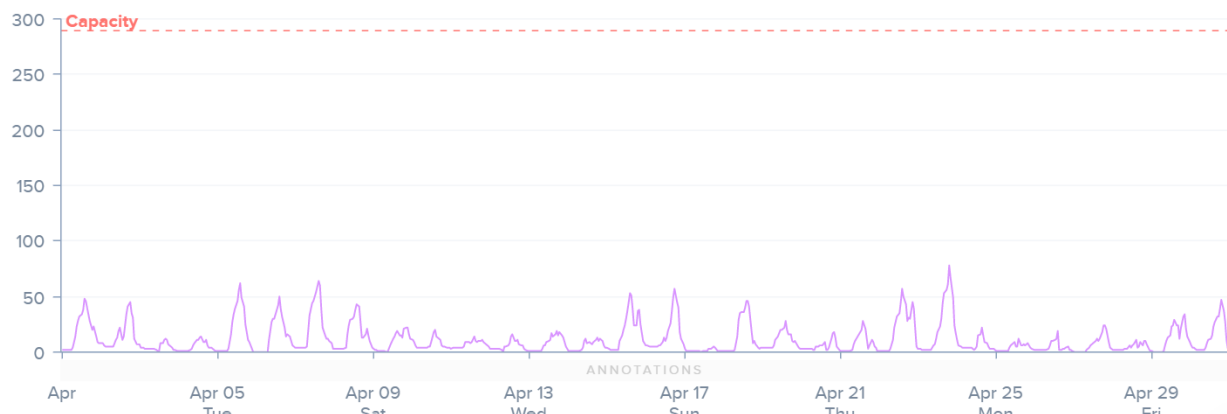
April 2022 Transient Garage Occupancy – Union Street Garage
