The purpose of this amendment 16 is to revise the text of Sections 5-8-84(b)(1) and 5-8-112 which will ensure that the Director of the Department of Transportation and Environmental Services (the Department) and designees 17 18 have the authority to set rates for pay by phone parking and open-air off-street parking. This 19 ordinance, along with the attached resolution, will provide the Department with the flexibility 20 necessary to implement recommendations of the Old Town Area Parking and Work Group for 21 encouraging long term visitors to use off-street parking facilities. The proposed amendment will 22 also allow for the expansion of the pay by phone program by eliminating Section 5-8-84(c)(2), 23 which specifies the geographic limit for program eligibility.
