As a child in an American military family living in Germany for many years, I developed a deep appreciation for the winding streets and centuriesold buildings that created a distinctive sense of place in European cities that so many American communities seemed to lack. These were thriving, modern, vibrant communities—shaped by the past, but not trapped in a time capsule. I believe this also describes Alexandria and our two historic districts, and it's what makes the city so special and unique. I find Alexandria to be an exciting blend of old and new. and I am a proud resident of the city. I've been in public service for all of my adult life. I was an active-duty Army officer for 14 years, first as a combat engineer and later, via a sponsored Army program, I became a lawyer in the Army JAG Corps. Statement of Interest/Why You Should Be Appointed

As a resident of the Old and Historic Alexandria District, I developed an intense interest in the architectural and cultural heritage of the national treasure we call Alexandria. Exploring our past and enjoying our present has revealed the complex interconnections within our city that must function in unison to preserve the vitality of Alexandria and preserve its appeal for the full spectrum of our residents. Although my initial focus was on historic preservation, greater involvement in the our city helped me appreciate that historic preservation is part of a matrix of important elements of Alexandria's well-being and must be integrated into and balanced with other priorities that together comprise a thriving, healthy city. Historic preservation can only be faithfully exercised in the context of the tourism dollars that it brings to our economy and the importance of housing for all who work and live here. Initiatives such as the Alexandria Community Remembrance Project and Freedom House Museum have starkly highlighted major aspects of our heritage that must be incorporated to provide a robust, complete mosaic of our past through which we can enjoy a diverse, inclusive community. One of my most important initiatives as chair of the Historic Alexandria Resources Commission (HARC) has been detailed evaluation of its composition and recommended changes to enhance diversity and inclusiveness. For example, there are two seats on HARC for historic, primarily White churches but no seats for our historic, primarily Black churches. Over the past decades, I have spoken before the Board of Architectural Review on dozens of issues and understand its mission, composition, and operations. Familiarity with Design Guidelines that provide the foundation for BAR decisions was necessary for my own property restoration, for real estate transactions, and for crafting sound preservation advice to city leaders and staff on behalf of HARC. That commission played a role in the recent discussion of bonus height allowance for added affordable housing which appears to have been equitably resolved. Those and similar activities have provided experience in a broad range of city operations and an effective understanding of city processes. In addition, I have completed the training for BAR members and staff (Commission Assistance and Mentoring Program) offered by the National Association of Preservation Commissions. That comprehensive, two-day program addressed standards and guidelines for design review, due process and decision making, fundamentals of preservation law, public outreach and community engagement, and other relevant topics. My family's 200 year old home has been in our family for almost 60 years, and is protected by both interior and exterior historic easements. I served as general contractor for a full renovation and updating of the property about 20 years ago. Over the years, we have gained a deep appreciation of Alexandria as a jewel among colonial cities and the hometown of George Washington. I began exploring Alexandria's history and contributing to its preservation with the Gadsby's Tavern Museum Society where I held several positions culminating in service as its President. I served for many years on the George Washington Birthday Celebration Committee in capacities including Vice Chair. There, I chaired the Cherry Challenge restaurant competition for years recruiting up to 60 participating restaurants and generating tens of thousands of dollars annually in local revenue. I also have presented guided walking tours of George Washington's Alexandria for well over a thousand visitors and residents. In addition to current service as the chair of HARC. I am a member of the Board of Directors of the Mortar and Pestle Society which is the friends group for the Stabler-Leadbeater Apothecary Museum. I have worked diligently for decades to preserve and enhance the historic character of our storied city and would be honored to continue those efforts as a member of the Board of Architectural Review. The Historic Alexandria Resources Commission serves an exceedingly important function by offering sound, balanced advice to city leaders and staff; and there are many accomplished, dedicated commissioners who can carry on that function in my stead.
