Statement of Interest/Why You Should Be Appointed

I'm writing to respectfully request that you consider my application for one of the open vacancies on the Environmental Policy Commission (urban planner). My education, experience, and interest position me as a worthwhile candidate, and if selected, I feel confident that I would be an excellent team member. I have a Masters degree in Urban Planning from Virginia Tech, which equipped me with a set of skills helpful to working on the Committee. These include cataloging existing resources, identifying threats and opportunities, and developing alternate scenarios. These abilities could be helpful for dealing with issues that might be the purview of the EPC. I've recently served on two public committees: the Potomac Yard Design Advisory Committee (PYDAC), and the Potomac Yard Metrorail Station Public Art Committee. Both committees allowed me to work with diverse groups of citizen experts and City Staff, and see firsthand how the committee structure is employed to resolve questions that affect a public with a variety of needs and aspirations. My career in landscape architecture has equipped me with many skills that overlap with urban planning: analysis of existing conditions, identification of opportunities and constraints, development and evaluation of alternate scenarios, and the ability to incorporate the needs of stakeholders. Landscape architecture goes further in imagining and designing at a more granular, humanscale the impact of infrastructure and policy decisions. My leadership experience with the American Society of Landscape Architects has been instructive and enriching. Last year I had the honor of serving as Chapter President for the Potomac Chapter, which has a membership of over 300 professionals in the DC-MD-VA metro area. One of my priorities was climate change, and understanding (and hopefully expanding) the role that landscape architects can have in addressing it. To this end, I coordinated the planning effort for a Regional Climate Action Summit, which was recently held in early June. This 2 day virtual event, in cooperation with ASLA Chapters in Maryland and Virginia, gathered professionals from landscape architecture, local planning experts (including Ellen Eggerton from the City of Alexandria), and academia for panels covering various aspects of climate change response in the realm of policy, design, and research. The event itself, as well as the planning stages, were helpful in gaining familiarity with a range of issues and actors working in the environmental and climate change sectors in our area. I've long felt compelled towards public service, and have looked for opportunities to use my time in a way that might benefit my family and community. The recently-adopted EAP provides an authoritative framework for stewarding our City's resources and transforming its responses to the challenges of climate change. I would value the opportunity to help administer and advise on the standards set forth in this and other guiding documents developed by the EPC. I'm a homeowner and proud resident of Alexandria, a truly unique place with a rich history, exemplary built fabric, and a caring, intelligent citizenry. It would be an honor to serve this community as a member of the Environmental Policy Commission, and I thank you for vour consideration.
