WHEREAS, the Chinquapin Wahoos, Alexandria’s only public swim team, won five meets to finish the summer 2022 season undefeated atop the blue division of the Colonial Swim League; and

WHEREAS, both the boys and girls teams were the top point earners in the blue division; and

WHEREAS, boys 8 and under, 9-10, 15-18 and girls 11-12 squads won the division; and

WHEREAS, the team won the blue division at the Colonial Swim League Relay Carnival with the boys 9-10 squad finishing first in the league in the 100-yard medley relay and the boys 15-18 squad breaking the league record in the 100-yard medley relay; and

WHEREAS, 27 swimmers qualified for the Cory Young All Star meet, with three swimmers winning five league titles; and

WHEREAS, multiple team records were broken as each swimmer contributed to a team effort and improved their personal fitness levels.
