10 AN ORDINANCE to grant to the Tall Ship Providence Foundation, its successors and assigns, a  
11 franchise under certain conditions, permitting the franchisee to use the public rights-of-way and  
12 on other public property to moor an historic or a replica historic tall ship for the operation of  
13 tours, private charters, sightseeing cruises, private events and educational programming at the  
14 City waterfront for the benefit of the public.

16 Summary

18 The proposed ordinance grants the Tall Ship Providence Foundation a franchise to moor a replica  
19 tall ship at the City marina. The initial term of the franchise is for ten years with an option,  
20 subject to City Council approval, to renew the franchise for three consecutive terms of five years  
21 each.
