Title

AN ORDINANCE Approving and Authorizing the Closure of the Unit Block of King Street and the Northern Portion of the Strand to Vehicular Traffic.

Summary

The proposed ordinance temporarily closes the unit block of King Street to vehicular traffic, between Union Street and the Strand, and the northern portion of the Strand between Wales Alley and King Street.

Estimated Costs of Implementation

If the closure is approved, there will be minimal costs associated with updating parking signage and refreshing striping. All of these costs can be handled with existing budgets. Also, since there will be four metered spaces eliminated along the Waterfront Park to provide turnaround space and parking for police, this will total approximately \$8,000 per year, or \$666/month.
