- 38% Affordable Units (50%-60% AMI)
- 25% Workforce Housing Units (80% AMI)

Housing Opportunities Fund Loan Request



- \$1 million request for North Building to be funded from the Housing Trust Fund -Braddock ARHA Reserve
- City's loan is subordinate; repaid from cash flow over 40-year period
- Loan will incorporate \$60,000 Pre-Development loan (2021)
- ARHA plans to apply in March 2023 for 9%/4% Low-Income Housing Tax Credits
- City financial support and Resolution designating the project site a Revitalization Area will provide points for Virginia Housing priority categories
