22	references to the King Street outdoor dining overlay; delete Section 7-1500 (Outdoor display,
23	sales or storage of goods or merchandise and outdoor dining in a parklet); delete all other
24	ordinance references to parklets, outdoor dining on sidewalks in the public right-of-way and
25	outdoor retail display and sales in the public right-of-way; amend Section 8-300 to waive
26	parking requirements for outdoor dining in the Central Business District; and amend Articles
27	III, IV, V, VI, XI to specify requirements for outdoor dining on private property.
