#### Statement of Interest/Why You Should Be Appointed

Thank you for considering my application for service on the Alexandria Renew Board of Directors. In the nearly 10 years that I've lived in Alexandria, I've admired the professionalism and integrity of the agencies and utilities that work together to make our City a wonderful place to live. I would be honored to contribute to that shared spirit of public service by applying my professional expertise to the AlexRenew Board. I am a nationally recognized expert in wastewater and stormwater law and policy, with over a decade of experience advocating for cleaner waterways and better water infrastructure in communities across the country. As a senior attorney at the Natural Resources Defense Council, I lobby for enhanced federal funding for wastewater and stormwater utilities, develop policies to ensure that water and sewer service is affordable for all people regardless of income, and advocate for the adoption of workable legal solutions to bring wastewater and stormwater systems into compliance with the Clean Water Act. Additionally, prior to my current focus on federal advocacy, I spent several years representing NRDC in a leadership role with the Choose Clean Water Coalition, an alliance of 200 environmental organizations working together to clean up the Chesapeake Bay. As a result, I have a strong understanding of how Bay restoration mandates - alongside local water quality goals - drive regulatory requirements for wastewater treatment plants and other dischargers. Like many Alexandrians, I'm excited about the transformational RiverRenew project that will reduce combined sewer overflows and accelerate the revitalization of the Potomac riverfront. I would love to contribute to that effort through service on the AlexRenew Board. Thanks to my experience in the environmental field, I understand the significance of this project both for our City's ecosystems and for the economic benefits a healthier Potomac River will generate. However, I'm also passionate about the less-publicized routine work of providing well-run and affordable sanitation services to our community. Operations, maintenance, and facility upgrades aren't as sensational as a massive tunnel boring machine, but those activities need robust support in order to keep our wastewater system running smoothly. If selected for this position, I would bring my enthusiasm for the nuts and bolts of utility oversight to the Board. I'd also be thrilled to serve as a messenger to the public who can communicate the great work that AlexRenew is doing. Perhaps most importantly, I would also contribute a focus on environmental and social justice that I believe is currently underrepresented on the Board. Many families across the City struggle to afford their wastewater bills, and I believe we can do more as a community to ensure that no one loses access to water and sanitation services due to an inability to pay. I would appreciate the chance to help balance the Board's perspectives on environmental, social, and financial concerns and keep Alexandria the thriving, healthy community we all love.

I have worked as an attorney at the Natural Resources Defense Council since 2009. In the past five years, I have held the following titles: Staff Attorney (2014-2017), Senior Attorney (2017-2018), and currently Senior Attorney & Deputy Director of Federal Water Policy (2018-present). NRDC is a national nonprofit environmental organization. At NRDC, my duties center around federal advocacy for strong legal protections for waterways and enhanced water infrastructure funding. My goals are to ensure safe, wellfunctioning sanitation in all communities and affordable water and sewer bills that allow families to maintain reliable access to these essential public services. In recent years I have also engaged deeply in clean water advocacy at the regional level in the Chesapeake Bay watershed (including in Virginia and the District of Columbia). I am a legal and policy specialist in matters relating to Clean Water Act permitting, green infrastructure, stormwater pollution, combined sewer overflows (CSOs), federal water infrastructure financing, water affordability policy, and climate resilience. Over the years I have developed a strong familiarity with regulatory requirements (such as the Clean Water Act, Virginia Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permits, the Chesapeake Bay total maximum daily load, CSO consent decrees and long-term control plans, and PFAS "forever chemicals" liability for wastewater facilities) as well as funding and financing programs (including the Clean Water State Revolving Fund and Low-Income Household Water Assistance Program) that are relevant to service on the Alexandria Renew Board of Directors. In my current role, I represent NRDC in coalitions and before legislative bodies, administrative agencies, and courts, while working in partnership with community leaders and small businesses. I testified before Congress in 2021 about legislative proposals to promote sustainable wastewater and stormwater infrastructure, and I've been invited to participate on a U.S. Government Accountability Office expert panel later this summer on potential reforms to federal wastewater financing programs. I regularly work with local and national media outlets to bring attention to water infrastructure issues. I have published white papers and law review articles on stormwater policy, equitable water infrastructure funding, and the Clean Water Act. Finally, the more administrative aspects of my position at NRDC have provided me with experience managing budgets, contracts, and consultants, which are important functions of AlexRenew Board members.
