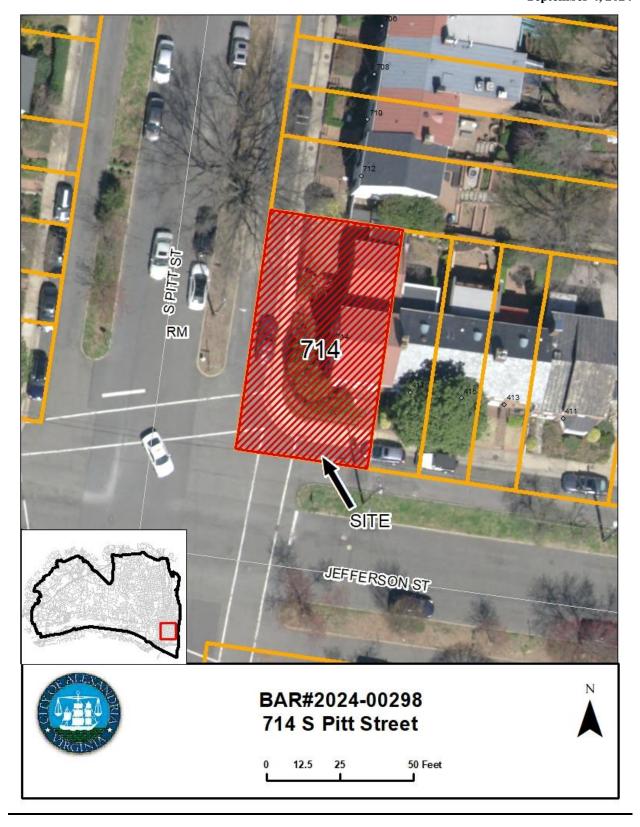

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approval of the Certificate of Appropriateness for alterations and Waiver of Vision Clearance requirement, as submitted.

GENERAL NOTES TO THE APPLICANT

- 1. APPEAL OF DECISION: In accordance with the Zoning Ordinance, if the Board of Architectural Review denies or approves an application in whole or in part, the applicant or opponent may appeal the Board's decision to City Council on or before 14 days after the decision of the Board.
- 2. COMPLIANCE WITH BAR POLICIES: All materials must comply with the BAR's adopted policies unless otherwise specifically approved.
- 3. BUILDING PERMITS: Most projects approved by the Board of Architectural Review require the issuance of one or more construction permits by Department of Code Administration (<u>including signs</u>). The applicant is responsible for obtaining all necessary construction permits after receiving Board of Architectural Review approval. Contact Code Administration, Permit Center, 4850 Mark Center Drive, Suite 2015, 703-746-4200 for further information.
- 4. ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATES OF APPROPRIATENESS AND PERMITS TO DEMOLISH: Applicants must obtain a copy of the Certificate of Appropriateness or Permit to Demolish PRIOR to applying for a building permit. - 5. EXPIRATION OF APPROVALS NOTE: In accordance with Sections 10-106(B), 10-206(B) and 10-307 of the Zoning Ordinance, any Board of Architectural Review approval will expire 12 months from the date of issuance if the work is not commenced and diligently and substantially pursued by the end of that 12-month period.
- 6. HISTORIC PROPERTY TAX CREDITS: Applicants performing extensive, certified rehabilitations of historic properties may separately be eligible for state and/or federal tax credits. Consult with the <u>Virginia Department of Historic Resources (VDHR)</u> prior to initiating any work to determine whether the proposed project may qualify for such credits.



I. <u>APPLICANT'S PROPOSAL</u>

The applicant requests a Certificate of Appropriateness and Waiver of Vision Clearance requirement to increase the height of portions of the east masonry wall to six feet, as well as alterations at 717 South Pitt Street. The existing east masonry wall height varies with its highest portion at 6'. The applicant proposes to increase the height of the entire east wall to 6' and install a wrought iron gate at the walkway. The masonry wall on the south side of the property (Jefferson Street) will not be altered.

Site context

The subject property is a corner lot, and the existing masonry wall is located in a vision clearance area and the proposed alterations will exceed the height limitations of front yard fences as noted in BAR's policies.

II. <u>HISTORY</u>

The three-bay, two-story townhouse consists of a masonry main block and a one-story masonry ell. The subject was constructed in **1939** as part of the first section of the Yates Gardens neighborhood. The one-story masonry addition was approved by the BAR on August 5, 1970.

III. ANALYSIS

Certificate of Appropriateness

Staff has no objections to the proposed alterations and waiver of vision clearance requirement. The *Design Guidelines* state that garden walls and gates are an important visual feature of the historic districts. Additionally, garden walls also provide a sense of privacy and enclosure for the property owners. The proposed garden wall and gate are architecturally appropriate in material, design, scale and character of the structure it surrounds. The modified masonry wall will give the applicant the desired level of privacy while maintaining the character of the blockface.

Zoning

C-1 Proposed wall expansion will comply with zoning if height is approved by BAR.

Code Administration

Per VRC R108.2 Exemptions from application for permit: Concrete or masonry walls, provided such walls do not exceed 6 feet (1829 mm) in height above the finished grade. Ornamental column caps shall not be considered to contribute to the height of the wall and shall be permitted to extend above the 6-foot (1829 mm) height measurement. No permit is required for brick wall less than 6ft.

Transportation and Environmental Services

- R-1The building permit must be approved and issued prior to the issuance of any permit for demolition, if a separate demolition permit is required. (T&ES)
- R-2Applicant shall be responsible for repairs to the adjacent city right-of-way if damaged during construction activity. (T&ES)
- R-3No permanent structure may be constructed over any existing private and/or public utility easements. It is the responsibility of the applicant to identify any and all existing easements on the plan. (T&ES)

- F-1 The applicant should provide a determination of disturbed area per City Guidelines to T&ES prior to submitting for permits. If the land disturbance meets or exceeds 2500 square feet, a released grading plan will be required prior to submitting for permits. (T&ES)
- C-1The applicant shall comply with the City of Alexandria's Solid Waste Control, Title 5, Chapter 1, which sets forth the requirements for the recycling of materials (Sec. 5-1-99). (T&ES)
- C-2The applicant shall comply with the City of Alexandria's Noise Control Code, Title 11, Chapter 5, which sets the maximum permissible noise level as measured at the property line. (T&ES)
- C-3Roof, surface and sub-surface drains be connected to the public storm sewer system, if available, by continuous underground pipe.
