- Providing parking per the Zoning Ordinance




KING STREET PERSPECTIVE: SOUTH BOUND



Re-zoning Request

- R-8 to RB zone (with proffers)
- Allows for the proposed use 'Nursing Home'
 - Closest specific definition in ZO
- Allows for a larger building: 0.75 FAR
- Conformance to master plan
- Intensity of new zone

- Each floor divided into two neighborhoods.
- Enhances the residents overall experience.

Site Design

- Footprint adjusted to the triangular site
- 55 feet setback from front property line
- 4 surface parking spaces
- 39% open space

Modifications Requested

- 32.5 ft. side setback on north
- 8 ft. side setback on south / east
- Amount of parking area in a yard



Tree Preservation

- TPE was recorded for the previous site plan approval (2005)
- Proposed to be moved to cover different trees on site
- Currently covers 9 trees (3 with disease or dieback)
- Caliper for caliper replacement of trees lost (min. 24 new trees)
