1 am writing to you this evening on behalf of our 3,300 members and supporters in the City of Alexandria regarding SB 882 being considered in the Virginia General Assembly.

Virginia remains one of a handful of states that does not prohibit motor vehicle occupants from opening a vehicle door "adjacent to moving traffic unless it is reasonably safe to do so." The District of Columbia and Maryland both already have dooring statues. SB 882 patroned by Senator Chap Petersen would create a simple \$100 traffic infraction, not subject to driver demerit points and not applicable to emergency responders, for doing so. The bill has been amended to reduce the fine to \$50, and change the work "occupant" to "operator", and has passed the Senate 27-12, with strong support in Northern Virginia and opposition from those in the state who vote frequently against measures to improve traffic safety.

This law is a good one for all road users. Data collected by Virginia's DMV indicates that 65 individuals were injured (13 were bicyclists) in 209 crashes from 2010-2014 that involved persons in vehicles who opened or kept the vehicle door open and the passing vehicle struck the car door. The presence of this law and the associated education campaign would help reduce if not eliminate this source of injuries.

Virginia is one of only a few remaining states without laws preventing drivers from injuring people or causing damage to property with their car door.
