I am writing to support the reappointment of Patricia Evans as a citizen member of the Alexandria Law Library Board. Dr. Evans is currently the only librarian on their board and has been a leader in finding a solution to keep a public law library available to the citizens of Alexandria. Whether that will be as an independent entity or as some part of the Alexandria public library is still under study. To facilitate that study, Pat was responsible for asking the National Center for State Courts to provide an independent mediator to advise the Law Library board about what has happened in other jurisdictions.

Dr. Evans holds a doctorate and a Master's in Library Science and works as a research librarian at the Supreme Court of the United States. She is an active member of the American Library Association and teaches at the library science Master's program at Catholic University.

When the Law Library lost its full funding in the FY15 budget cycle, it was Dr. Evans who actively reached out to the Alexandria Library and Library Board to ask for advice. She is a supporter of the Alexandria Library, serving as membership chair of the Friends of Burke Library, and attends many of the library's civic programs.

As both organizations work with the acting City Manager and the Council in a search for a solution to the Law Library's future, it would be very helpful to have Ms. Evans' background, experience, and contacts available on the Law Library Board.

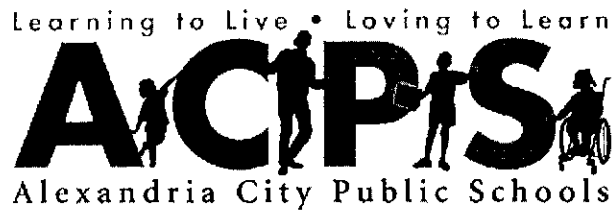
