Additionally, I regularly research and analyze federal law, including agency regulations, to determine scope of application to Puerto Rico and the other U.S. territories. Recent work has included drafting of legislation to reauthorize the Coral Reef Conservation Act of 2000, the National Sea Grant College Program Act, the Coastal Zone Management Act, and amendments to the Agricultural Research, Extension, and Education Reform Act of 1998 to authorize new federal grants to develop and implement areawide integrated pest management plans for the control and eradication of agricultural pests and invasive species. I have also worked on securing federal appropriations for the recovery of listed animal and plant species under the Endangered Species Act of 1973. Recent work has also encompassed legislation and educational advocacy addressing the impacts of climate change and the adoption of strategies for climate change adaptation. I am also involved in facilitating timely federal review, permitting and budgeting of several Army Corps flood control and ecosystem restoration projects in Puerto Rico, and the Southeast Region of the United States, including a 3.5-mile channel that functions as a key hydrological connection for the San Juan Bay estuary ecosystem in urban San Juan, Puerto Rico, and that presently contains some Hazardous, Toxic and Radioactive Waste (HTRW) contaminants regulated under the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA), and also municipal waste regulated under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA). Recent achievements include enactment through the FY2015 National Defense Authorization Act of legislation authorizing the Department of Defense to remove unexploded ordnance (UXO) and military munitions from land and water that constitutes a former live-fire military weapons training range. I am also working to address timely compliance with the Mercury and Air Toxics Standards (MATS) and the carbon pollution



standards by the power utility in Puerto Rico that have been promulgated by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) under the Clean Ai r Act, and with the Clean Water Act and Safe Drinking Water Act regulations by the water and wastewater utility in Puerto Rico that have also been promulgated by EPA. Past work has also focused on the renewable energy standard (RFS), biofuels, LEED construction requirements for federal buildings, and infrastructure supporting liquefied natural gas (LNG) infrastructure development. I coordinated multiple U.S. Government Accountability Office (GAO) studies that addressed expenditure of federal funds and the application of federal law in the U.S. territories, including in the areas of social welfare prog rams and maritime trade. I also served as the lead committee analyst for communications with multiple government agencies, including the White House Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ), the Department of Defense (DOD), the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (FWS), the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), and state and local natural resource management agencies, in the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) process supporting the rebasing of approximately 9,000 United States Marines, and accompanying 8,000 dependents, from Okinawa, Japan to the U.S. territory of Guam, and the homeporting of an aircraft carrier battle group in the harbor on Guam, as well as the beddown of a U.S. missile defense shield unit on Guam, that involved complex and comprehensive analysis of a range of environmental impacts and associated compensatory mitigation options. This proposed federal action represents the largest single peacetime relocation of uniformed military personnel in DOD history, and one of the most voluminous Environmental Impact Statements (numbering over 6,000 pages without appendices) ever produced in the history of the NEPA statute.
