History



- Authorized by State Law in 1950
- Issues tax-exempt industrial revenue bonds
- Designed to promote commerce, safety, health, welfare, convenience or prosperity of citizens in Alexandria
- Induce nonprofit enterprises to locate or remain in Virginia

Alexandria IDA



- Business incentive and retention tool
- Creates and retains jobs in Alexandria
- Increases the commercial tax base
- Adds to the association and non-profit cluster
- Adds temporary construction jobs
- Results in permitting fees for the City

Alexandria IDA



- Assisted 64 non-profits with bond financing since 1998
- Issued \$915 million in revenue bonds
- Collected \$1.7 million in fees from applicants to support economic development activities

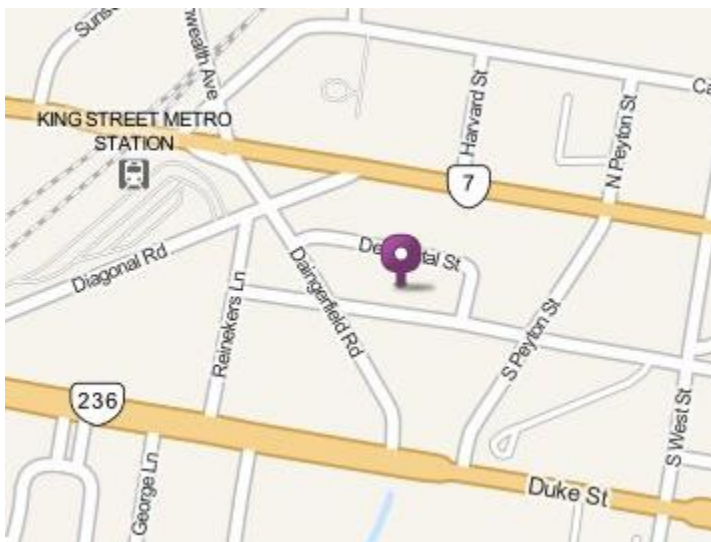
