17	(a) The maximum fees that may be charged for the towing of motor vehicles and for the

20	(1) for the towing of a motor vehicle (i) less than 7,500 pounds gross vehicle weight
21	rating, the maximum fee shall be $\frac{125}{135}$ ; (ii) for medium tows, 7,500 to 10,000
22	pounds gross vehicle weight rating, the maximum fee shall be \$250; (iii) for heavy
23	tows, greater than 10,000 pounds gross vehicle weight rating, the maximum fee shall

32	It shall be unlawful for any tow truck service or operator to tow a motor vehicle unless the area in
33	which the vehicle is parked has posted, at each entrance, a legible sign of a minimum size of 12
34	inches by 18 inches that contains the following:

36	(a) a pictorial symbol of a tow truck;
37	(b) a statement, in letters not less than three one and one half inches in height, to the effect
38	that any trespassing motor vehicle within the area is subject to towing and storage at the
39	expense of the vehicle owner;
