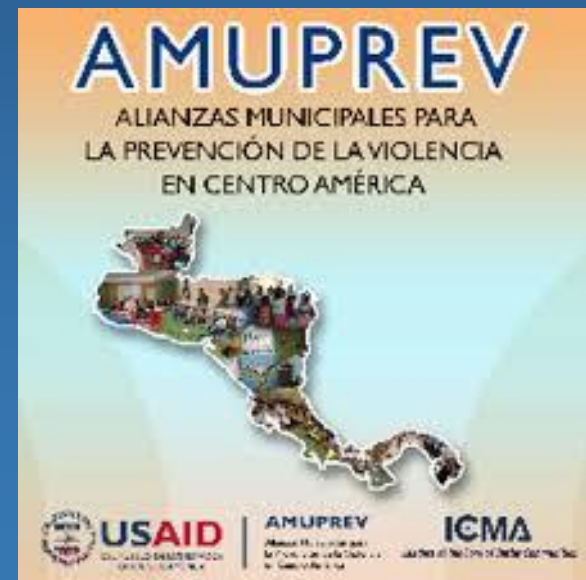

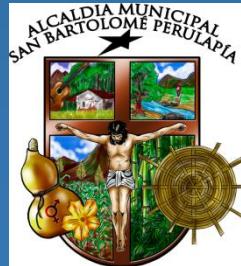


US AID / AMUPREV

PHASED APPROACH

- **Spring 2014** – ICMA approaches the City
- **June 2014** – Three municipalities selected:

- **July 2014** – Alexandria delegation visits El Salvador
- **October 2014** – Three mayors and their delegation from El Salvador municipalities visit Alexandria
- **April 2015** – Alexandria delegation visits El Salvador
