18	Section 2. That Section 2-4-71 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as
19	amended, be, and the same hereby is, amended and reordained to read as follows:
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21	Sec. 2-4-71 - Creation, composition and organization.
22	(a) There is hereby established a committee known as the housing affordableability housing
23	advisory committee.
24	(b) The voting membership shall consist of 14 citizen members who shall be appointed by city
25	council. The composition of the voting membership shall be as follows:
26	(1) one commissioner from the Alexandria Redevelopment and Housing Authority;
27	(2) one licensed and practicing attorney;
28	(3) one builder or developer of residential property;
29	(4) one real estate professional with knowledge and experience in residential real estate;
30	(5) one financial professional with knowledge and experience in the field of finance as it relates
31	to residential housing;
32	(6) one landlord of residential property in the city;
33	(7) one residential tenant in the city;
34	(8) one homeowner in the city;
35	(9) one representative of the city's faith community;
36	(10) one representative of a civic association in the city;
37	(11) one representative who is employed by or affiliated with an organization that promotes and
38 39	maintains affordable housing; (12) one representative of an employer in the city who employs at least 100 employees;
40	(12) one representative of an employer in the city who employs at least 100 employees, (13) one person designated by, but who need not be a member of, the Commission on Aging; and
40 41	(14) one person who is either a City employee or a teacher with the Alexandria City Public
41	Schools-;
43	(15) one person who represents housing consumers under 30 years of age:
44	(16) one community banker;
45	(17) one representative of the city's small business community;
46	(18) one representative of the city's retail, restaurant, or hospitality sector, designated by the
47	Alexandria Chamber of Commerce; and
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- 1 (19) one person designated by, but who need not be a member of, the Commission on Persons
- 2 with Disabilities.
- 3 (c) The non-voting membership of the committee shall consist of three representatives of the city
- 4 who will serve in an advisory capacity. The city representative members shall consist of one
- 5 representative of each of the following city departments:
- 6 (1) the office of housing;
- 7 (2) the department of planning and zoning; and
- 8 (3) the department of human services.
- 9 (d) Voting members of the committee shall be appointed in the manner prescribed in article A of
- 10 this chapter. Such members shall be appointed to three-year staggered terms and shall be eligible
- for reappointment. One-third of the initial appointments shall be for a one year term, one-third of 11
- 12 the initial appointments shall be for a two-year term, and one-third of the initial appointments
- 13 shall be for a three-year term. Initial terms of office shall be determined by lot at the first committee meeting. Non-voting members shall be appointed by the city manager.
