WHEREAS, Del serves on the boards of the YMCA, the T.C. Williams PTSA, the Alexandria Arts Forum, the Retired Senior Volunteer Program, and is affiliated with the Urban League, the League of Women Voters, and the Sierra Club; and

WHEREAS, Del is a recipient of the Jaycees Appreciation Award, the Council of Senior Citizens Organization's Outstanding Women of Alexandria Award, and the Commission for Women's Living Legend Award.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Alexandria City Council and the City of Alexandria wishes to recognize Redella S. Pepper for her 30 years of service as a member of the Alexandria City Council and her continued strong commitment to the betterment of Alexandria.
