3	AN ORDINANCE authorizing the owners of the property located at 200 Strand Street to
4	construct and maintain an encroachment for a stoop, stairs, canopy and building overhang onto
5	the Prince Street right of way at that location as approved by the City Council on March 14,
6	2015.
7 8	WHEREAS, the Old Dominion Boat Club is the Owners ("Owners") of the property
9	located at 200 Strand Street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia; and
10	located at 200 Straind Street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and
11	WHEREAS, Owners desire to establish and maintain a stoop, stairs, canopy and a
12	building overhang which will encroach into the public right-of-way on Prince Street at that
13	location; and
14	
15	WHEREAS, the public right-of-way at that location will not be significantly
16	impaired by this encroachment; and
17	
18	WHEREAS, in Encroachment No. 2014-0006 the Planning Commission of the City
19	of Alexandria recommended approval to the City Council subject to certain conditions at one of
20	its regular meetings held on March 3, 2015 which recommendation was approved by the City
21	Council at its public hearing on March 14, 2015 and
22	WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Council of the City of Alexandria that
23 24	this encroachment is not detrimental to the public interest; now, therefore,
25	this encroaciment is not detrimental to the paone interest, now, therefore,
26	THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:
27	
28	Section 1. That Owners be, and the same hereby are, authorized to establish and
29	maintain encroachments into the Prince Street public right-of-way at 200 Strand Street in the
30	City of Alexandria, as shown in the attached Encroachment Plat prepared by Christopher
31	Consultants and dated November 4, 2014 and signed on September 28, 2015 attached hereto as
32	attachment A, said encroachment consisting of an entryway stoop, stairs and canopy, labeled as
33	"Stair Encroachment" and a building overhang for the balcony labeled as "Building Above
34	Encroachment", until the encroachment is removed or destroyed or the authorization to maintain
35	it is terminated by the city; provided, that this authorization to establish and maintain the
36	encroachment shall not be construed to relieve Owners of liability for any negligence on their
37	part on account of or in connection with the encroachment and shall be subject to the provisions set forth below.

40	Section 2. That the authorization hereby granted to establish and maintain said
41	encroachment shall be subject to and conditioned upon Owners maintaining, at all times and at
42	their own expense, liability insurance, covering both bodily injury and property damage, with a
43	company authorized to transact business in the Commonwealth of Virginia and with minimum
44	limits as follows:

1 2 Bodily Injury: \$1,000,000 each occurrence \$1,000,000 aggregate 3 4 5 Property Damage: \$1,000,000 each occurrence 6 7 \$1,000,000 aggregate 8 9 This liability insurance policy shall identify the City of Alexandria and Owners as named 10 insureds and shall provide for the indemnification of the City of Alexandria and Owners against any and all loss occasioned by the establishment, construction, placement, existence, use or 11 maintenance of the encroachment. Evidence of the policy and any renewal thereof shall be filed 12 with the city attorney's office. Any other provision herein to the contrary notwithstanding, in the 13 event this policy of insurance lapses, is canceled, is not renewed or otherwise ceases to be in 14 force and effect, the authorization herein granted to establish and maintain the encroachment 15 shall, at the option of the city, forthwith and without notice or demand by the city, terminate. In 16 that event, Owners shall, upon notice from the city, remove the encroachment from the public 17 right-of-way, or the city, at its option, may remove the encroachment at the expense and risk of 18 Owners. Nothing in this section shall relieve Owners of their obligations and undertakings 19 required under this ordinance. 20 21 22 23 24 25 (a)

Section 3. That the authorization hereby granted to establish and maintain said encroachment shall in addition be subject to and conditioned upon the following terms:

- Neither the City of Alexandria nor any public or private utility company shall be responsible for damage to Owners' property encroaching into the public right-of-way during repair, maintenance or replacement of the public right-of-way or any public facilities or utilities in the area of encroachment.
- (b) The Owners shall be responsible for replacement and repairs to the adjacent City right-of-way, including any areas damaged during construction activity.
- (c) In the event the City shall, in the future, have need for the area of the proposed encroachment, the Owners shall remove any structure that encroached into the public right-of-way, within 60 days, upon notification by the City.

Section 4. That by accepting the authorization hereby granted to establish and maintain the encroachment and by so establishing and/or maintaining the encroachment, Owners shall be deemed to have promised and agreed to save harmless the City of Alexandria from any and all liability (including attorneys' fees and litigation expenses) arising by reason of the establishment, construction, placement, existence, use or maintenance of the encroachment.

Section 5. That the authorization herein granted to establish and maintain the 1 2 encroachment shall be subject to Owners maintaining the area of the encroachment at all times unobstructed and free from accumulation of litter, snow, ice and other potentially dangerous 3 4 matter. 5 Section 6. That nothing in this ordinance is intended to constitute, or shall be 6 7 deemed to be, a waiver of sovereign immunity by or on behalf of the City of Alexandria or any 8 of its officers or employees. 9 10 Section 7. That the authorization herein granted to establish and maintain the encroachment shall be terminated whenever the City of Alexandria desires to use the affected 11 public right-of-way for any purpose whatsoever and, by written notification, demands from 12 Owners the removal of the encroachment. Said removal shall be completed by the date specified 13 in the notice and shall be accomplished by Owners without cost to the city. If Owners cannot be 14 found, or shall fail or neglect to remove the encroachment within the time specified, the city shall 15 have the right to remove the encroachment, at the expense of Owners, and shall not be liable to 16 Owners for any loss or damage to the structure of the encroachment or personal property within 17 the encroachment area, caused by the removal. 18 19 Section 8. The terms "Owners" shall be deemed to include the Old Dominion Boat 20 21 Club and its successors in interest. 22 Section 9. That this ordinance shall be effective upon the date and at the time of its 23 final passage. 24 25 26 WILLIAM D.
