That Title 5, Chapter 8, Article G of the Code of the City of Alexandria, 13 Virginia, 1981, as amended, be, and the same hereby is, amended and reordained, to read as 14 follows: 15 16 (New language is underscored; deleted material is stricken) 17 18 Sec. 5-8-92 - Parking meter zones established. 19 20 (Intervening sections are unchanged) 21 22 (d) The following described parts of the streets of the city are hereby established as parking 23 meter zone 4: 24 (1) both sides of the 2900 and 3000 blocks of Dogue Street 25 (2) both sides of the 2800, 2900, and 3000 blocks of Main Line Boulevard 26 (3) both sides of the 700 and 800 blocks of Seaton Avenue 27 (4) west side of the 2800, 2900, and 3000 blocks of Potomac Avenue 28 (5) both sides of the 600 and 700 block of Maskell Street 29 (6) both sides of the 600, 700, and 800 block of East Glebe Road 30 (de) The number and locations of parking meters in the zones established above shall be 31 determined by the city manager or the manager's designee; provided, that any proposal to 32 locate new or remove existing meters shall be submitted by the manager or designee to the 33 traffic and parking board for its review and recommendation; and provided further, that, in 34 the event the manager or designee disagrees with the recommendation of the board, the 35 proposal shall be submitted to city council which shall make the final decision on the 36 proposal. 37 38 Sec. 5-8-93 - Parking meters; hours and days of operation; maximum time limits; rates. 39 40 (a) (1) The parking meters in zones 1 and 2, established by section 5-8-92 of this code, 41 shall be operated every day of the week except Sundays and legal state holidays, and the daily hours of operation of the meters shall be determined by resolution of the city 42 43 council; provided, that, within the area bounded on the north by the north side of Princess 44 Street, on the west by a line 10 feet to the east of and running parallel to the east side of

Washington Street, on the south by the south side of Wolfe Street and on the east by the

1	Potomac River, meters which permit a maximum of two hours of parking shall be in
2	operation from 8:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m.
3	(2) The parking meters in zones 3 and 4, established by section 5-8-92 of this code
4	shall be operated every day of the week except Sundays and state legal holidays, and the
5	daily hours of operation of the meters shall be determined by resolution of the city
6	council.

8	(b) The maximum time limit for parking in any space in parking meter zones 1, 2, and 3, and
9	4 shall be set forth on the meter for that space, and shall be 20 minutes, two hours, three hours
10	or, in zones 1 and 3 only, four hours.
