WHEREAS, in 2001 the thousand seat Rachel M. Schlesinger Concert Hall and Arts Center was completed and welcomed as part of the City's art community; and

WHEREAS, today with more than 75,000 students from 150 countries enrolled on six regional campuses Northern Virginia Community College is the largest higher education institution in both the Commonwealth of Virginia and the Metropolitan Washington Region.
