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3	AN ORDINANCE authorizing the owner of the property located at 600 Wolfe Street to construct
4	and maintain an encroachment for handicapped accessible ramp at that location approved by
5	the City Council on January 30, 2016.

7	WHEREAS, Little Theatre of Alexandria is the Owner ("Owner") of the property
8	located at 600 Wolfe Street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia; and
9	WHERE AC Owner desire to establish and maintain a handisagned accessible name
10	WHEREAS, Owner desire to establish and maintain a handicapped accessible ramp
11	which will encroach into the public right-of-way at that location; and
12	WHEDEAS the public right of way at that location will not be cignificantly
13	WHEREAS, the public right-of-way at that location will not be significantly
14 15	impaired by this encroachment; and
16	WHEREAS, in Encroachment No. 2015-0006 the Planning Commission of the City
17	of Alexandria recommended approval to the City Council subject to certain conditions at one of
18	its regular meetings held on January 5, 2016, which recommendation was approved by the City
19	Council at its public hearing on January 30, 2016 and
20	council at its public hearing on vantaary 50, 2010 and
21	WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Council of the City of Alexandria that
22	this encroachment is not detrimental to the public interest; now, therefore,
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24	THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:
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26	Section 1. That Owner be, and the same hereby are, authorized to establish and
27	maintain an encroachment into the public right-of-way at 600 Wolfe Street in the City of
28	Alexandria as shown on the Encroachment Plat dated February 9, 2016 attached hereto and
29	incorporated herein by this reference, said encroachment consisting of <u>a handicapped accessible</u>
30	<u>ramp</u> , until the encroachment is removed or destroyed or the authorization to maintain it is
31	terminated by the city; provided, that this authorization to establish and maintain the
32	encroachment shall not be construed to relieve Owner of liability for any negligence on their part
33	on account of or in connection with the encroachment and shall be subject to the provisions set
34	forth below.
35	
36	Section 2. That the authorization hereby granted to establish and maintain said
37	encroachment shall be subject to and conditioned upon Owner maintaining, at all times and at
38	their own expense, liability insurance, covering both bodily injury and property damage, with a
39	company authorized to transact business in the Commonwealth of Virginia and with minimum
40	limits as follows:
41	Bodily Injury: \$1,000,000 each occurrence
42 43	\$1,000,000 each occurrence \$1,000,000 aggregate
43	ψ1,000,000 aggregate

Property Damage: \$1,000,000 each occurrence \$1,000,000 aggregate

This liability insurance policy shall identify the City of Alexandria and Owner as named insureds and shall provide for the indemnification of the City of Alexandria and Owner against any and all loss occasioned by the establishment, construction, placement, existence, use or maintenance of the encroachment. Evidence of the policy and any renewal thereof shall be filed with the city attorney's office. Any other provision herein to the contrary notwithstanding, in the event this policy of insurance lapses, is canceled, is not renewed or otherwise ceases to be in force and effect, the authorization herein granted to establish and maintain the encroachment shall, at the option of the city, forthwith and without notice or demand by the city, terminate. In that event, Owner shall, upon notice from the city, remove the encroachment from the public right-of-way, or the city, at its option, may remove the encroachment at the expense and risk of Owner. Nothing in this section shall relieve Owner of their obligations and undertakings required under this ordinance.

Section 3. That the authorization hereby granted to establish and maintain said encroachment shall in addition be subject to and conditioned upon the following terms:

(a) Neither the City of Alexandria nor any public or private utility company shall be responsible for damage to Owner's property encroaching into the public right-of-way during repair, maintenance or replacement of the public right-of-way or any public facilities or utilities in the area of encroachment.

(b) The Owner shall be responsible for replacement and repairs to the adjacent City right-of-way, including any areas damaged during construction activity.

(c) In the event the City shall, in the future, have need for the area of the proposed encroachment, the Owner shall remove any structure that encroached into the public right-of-way, within 60 days, upon notification by the City.

Section 4. That by accepting the authorization hereby granted to establish and maintain the encroachment and by so establishing and/or maintaining the encroachment, Owner shall be deemed to have promised and agreed to save harmless the City of Alexandria from any and all liability (including attorneys' fees and litigation expenses) arising by reason of the establishment, construction, placement, existence, use or maintenance of the encroachment.

Section 5. That the authorization herein granted to establish and maintain the encroachment shall be subject to Owner maintaining the area of the encroachment at all times unobstructed and free from accumulation of litter, snow, ice and other potentially dangerous matter.

Section 6. That nothing in this ordinance is intended to constitute, or shall be deemed to be, a waiver of sovereign immunity by or on behalf of the City of Alexandria or any of its officers or employees. Section 7. That the authorization herein granted to establish and maintain the encroachment shall be terminated whenever the City of Alexandria desires to use the affected public right-of-way for any purpose whatsoever and, by written notification, demands from Owner the removal of the encroachment. Said removal shall be completed by the date specified in the notice and shall be accomplished by Owner without cost to the city. If Owner cannot be found, or shall fail or neglect to remove the encroachment within the time specified, the city shall have the right to remove the encroachment, at the expense of Owner, and shall not be liable to Owner for any loss or damage to the structure of the encroachment or personal property within the encroachment area, caused by the removal. Section 8. That this ordinance shall be effective upon the date and at the time of its final passage.
