**WHEREAS**, music teachers Andrew Bawden, Alexandria Luke, Wesley McCune, Lindsey Serrao and Emily Smith have led their students in multiple performances both at school and in the community, and the team has participated with students in creative composition projects that allow students to explore their own musical creativity, while implementing creative lyric writing, theme and character development, and current events/issues; and

**WHEREAS**, Wesley McCune is retiring this year after teaching for 27 years, and he first formed the inspiration for ASO Sympatico in the Orff Ensemble 23 years ago, and has led the Orff Ensemble every morning since then, and we honor him for his many years of service.
