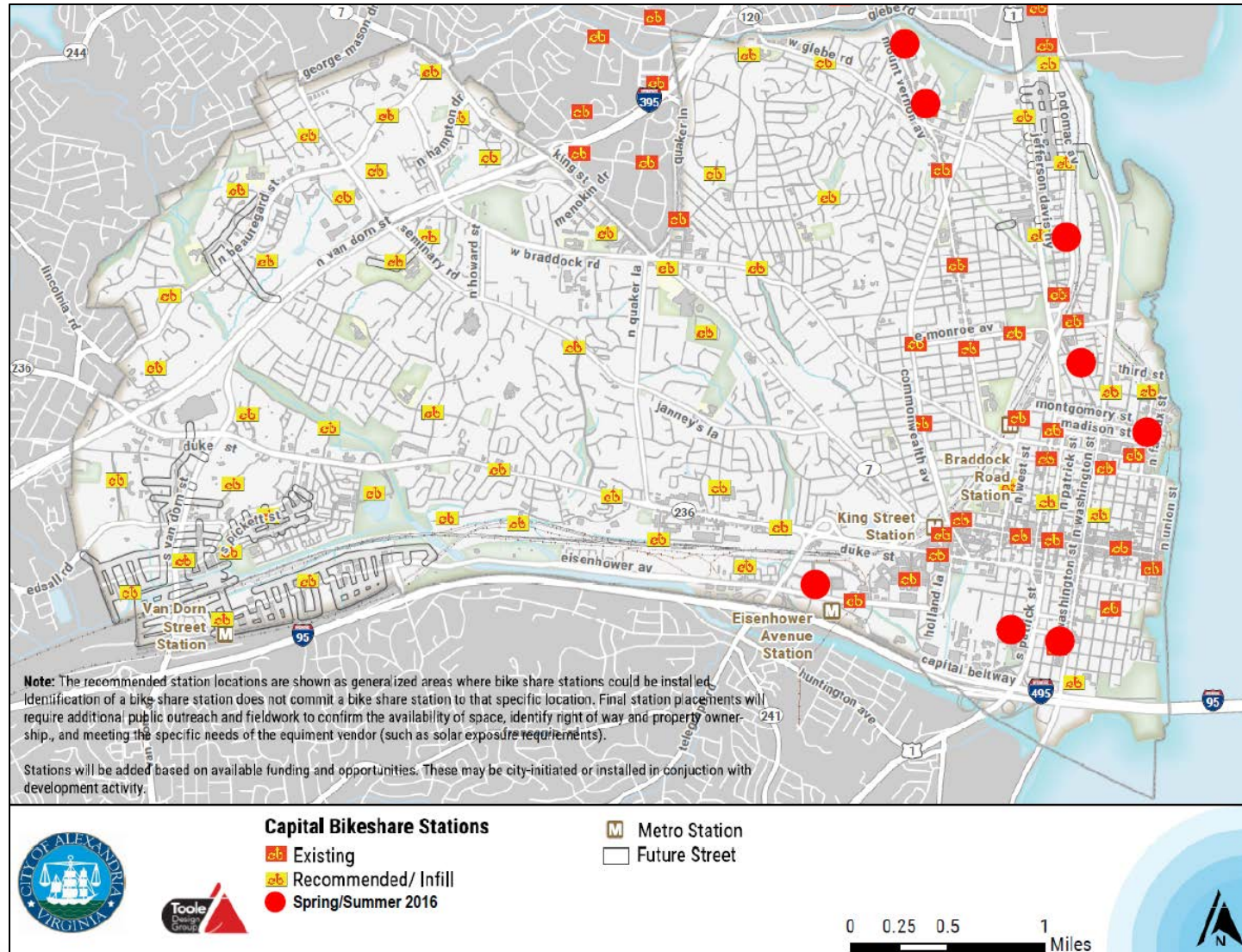
# Capital Bikeshare Overview

- Capital Bikeshare has 400 stations across the DC Metro system
- Alexandria has 24 stations and is adding 8 more in summer 2016
- Over 122,000 total trips in Alexandria
- Braddock Road Metro, King Street Metro and Market Square – most used stations
- Stations owned by the City and funded through grant and developer contributions
- Operations funded through system revenue and City funds

# Transportation Master Plan – Bikeshare

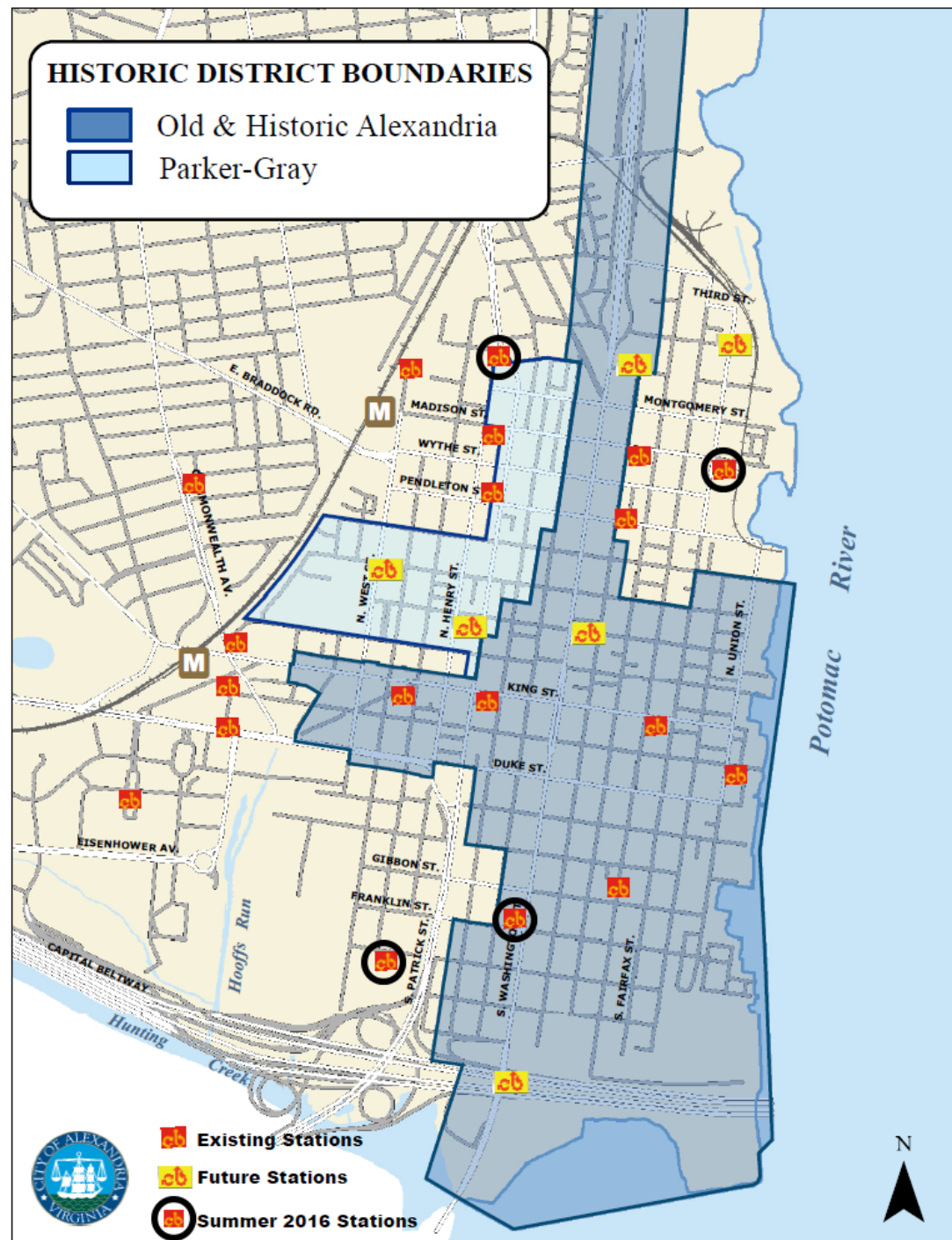
- Updated Pedestrian and Bicycle chapter – Approved by Council in May 2016
- Bikeshare Demand Analysis:
  - employment and population density
  - location of attractions (i.e., tourist destinations, parks, malls/shopping, schools and libraries)
  - transit density by ridership (i.e., metro and bus stops)
  - existing bicycling infrastructure
  - Topography
  - percentage of minority populations
  - percentage of zero-car households

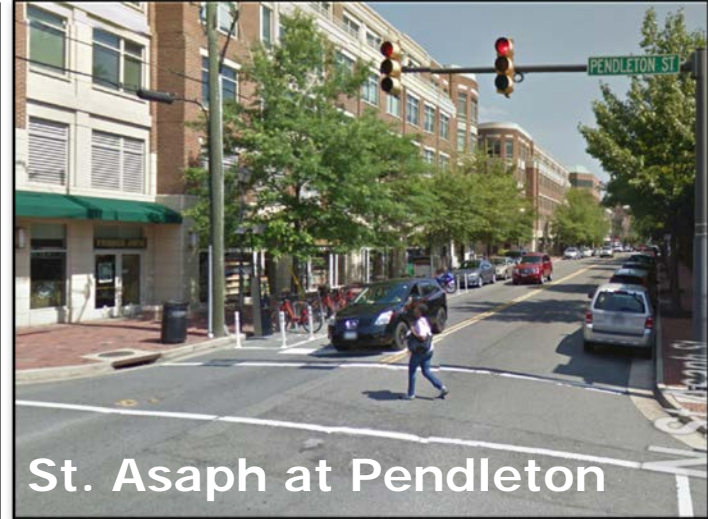

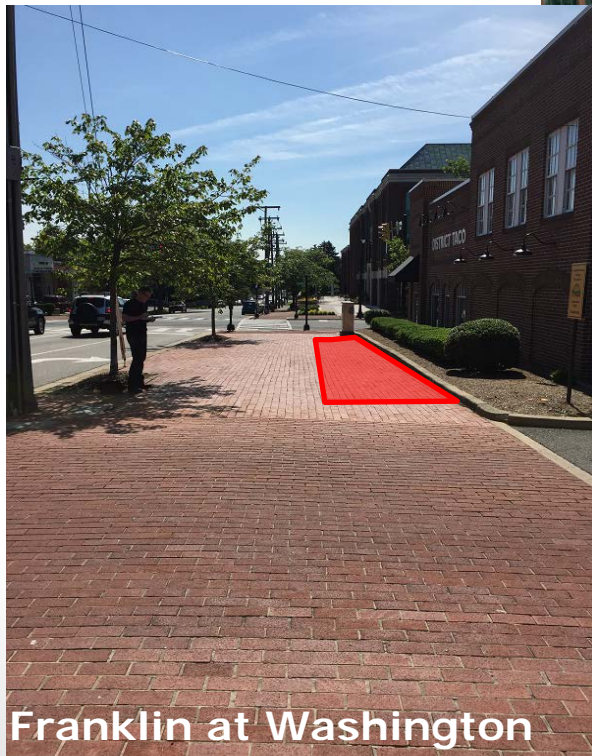
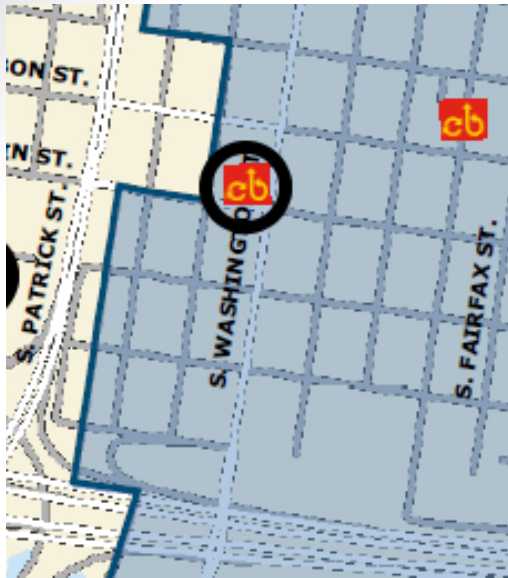
