- WHEREAS, more than 3.2 million American children are victims of bullying each year; and
- WHEREAS, 71% of students report incidents of bullying as a problem at their school; and
- **WHEREAS**, bullying continues to impact our nation's youth about 1 in 4 children in the United States are bullied on a regular basis; and
- WHEREAS, in Alexandria 13% of high school students and 25% of middle school students reported being bullied on school property and 13% reported being bullied electronically; and
- **WHEREAS**, as civic leaders in the City of Alexandria, we can and shall use our resources to increase awareness of the negative effects and to prevent bullying among our youth; and
- WHEREAS, the month of October is National Bullying Prevention Month, and Alexandria has again joined forces with over 200 other cities in United States Conference of Mayors through the Mayors' Campaign to End Bullying Bully Project which creates ongoing city-wide bullying prevention initiatives to make schools a safe place for all children; and
- WHEREAS, the local Mayor's Campaign to End Bullying committee members include city agencies, the school system, community organizations, youth leaders and community residents pledge to continue to host discussions, programs, activities and sporting events, to send a strong message to continue to help raise awareness and prevention under its "Bully Free Starts With Me!" theme; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City of Alexandria will do all it can to call attention to the issue of bullying in schools, workplace and cyberspace by developing educational and prevention awareness programs to ensure that all students have access to a safe and secure educational environment.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALLISON SILBERBERG**, Mayor of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and on behalf of the Alexandria City Council, do hereby proclaim the month of October as:

"NATIONAL BULLY PREVENTION MONTH"
