A multi-national traffic safety project that aims to achieve a transportation system with no deaths or serious injuries.


- Multidisciplinary approach to rethinking traffic safety

Vision Zero Policy

- Adopt goal of <u>zero traffic deaths and</u> <u>serious injuries by 2028</u>
- Engage the community in the development of a Vision Zero Action Plan
- Form an interdepartmental working group to develop an Action Plan that will:
 - Provide a comprehensive analysis of crashes
 - Outline the programs to reduce crashes
 - Identify associated funding needed
- Implement Action Plan strategies
- Provide an annual progress report on Action Plan implementation
