- 2. That said fee schedule shall be, and hereby is, approved and incorporated by reference in this resolution, and shall, until amended or rescinded, set forth the fees to be charged by the City of Alexandria Department of Planning and Zoning, beginning July 1, 2017; and
- 3. That this Resolution shall be effective on July 1, 2017.

# Comparison of Fees for Commercial Antenna Permits in Neighboring Jurisdictions

Alexandria does not charge a fee for administrative review and approval of commercial antenna installations at existing structures. For calendar year 2015, the City approved 30 antenna installations. Construction of new towers/monopoles would require a special use permit with a fee of \$575, but there have been no such applications in recent years. The table below shows that neighboring municipalities charge fees for their approvals of antenna installations. The more urban localities charge between \$1,871 and \$2,600 as their highest fee for installation approvals. The more suburban localities charge higher fees ranging from \$5,539 to \$16,375. These higher amounts are typically for freestanding tower/monopole installations.
