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A few small corrections for our minutes of May 9th, 2017.

1) The first item under Orals...At the bottom of page 15, the line should add "Capitol Hill" and a few other adjustments so that it explains the context of this advocacy. So it would read:

Mayor Silberberg said she joined two other mayors and the First Lady of New York City on Capitol Hill for a program called Cities Thrive, which is committed to increasing awareness about mental health issues and conditions, and the Mayor participated in this panel in order to raise awareness about Alexandria's best practices and to emphasize the importance of federal support for these programs.

The rest of the paragraph is fine.

2) The second item under Orals...On page 16, Debbie Ludington is spelled with one "d" in her last name, I believe.

3) The seventh item under Orals...On page 16, it states, "their hearts and thoughts go". I think it would make more sense if we stated it as follows, "the Council's hearts and thoughts go out..." Please add the word "Council's" and "out".

4) The ninth item under Orals...On page 16, instead of "Police and Sheriff," please have it read as: Police and Sheriff's Departments ...and then the rest is fine.
