- 5. The City is responsible for compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act, Endangered Species Act, Historic Preservation Act, Executive Orders 11988 and 11990 (Floodplain Management and Wetlands Protection) and all other applicable state and federal laws.
- 6. This resolution becomes part of a formal application to the Pet Safe Brand for the Bark for your Park Grant.
