4	AN ORDINANCE to authorize creation of the Old Town Business Improvement Service
5	District, pursuant to Code of Virginia § 15.2-2400, et seq.

7	WHEREAS, pursuant to \$15.2-2400 et seq. Va. Code Ann., the City Council is
8	authorized to establish service districts for the purpose of providing additional, more complete or
9	more timely services than may be needed, desired, or currently provided in the remainder of the
10	City; and
11	
12	WHEREAS, based upon the request of, and the support from business owners and
13	commercial property owners affected thereby, the City Council has determined a need exists to
14 15	provide some of the services authorized by law for service districts that promote, serve, and
15 16	benefit business owners and commercial property owners through the establishment of a service district within the area of the City of Alexandria known as Old Town, such service district to be
10	called the Old Town Business Improvement District (the "Old Town BID");
18	cance the old rown business improvement District (the 'old rown bid'),
19	THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:
20	
21	Section 1. The Old Town BID is hereby established, the boundaries of which shall be
22	as depicted on the map attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A, and which shall
23	encompass commercial properties and the commercial portions of mixed use properties within
24	the list of addresses attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit B, as further classified
25	Commercial by the City of Alexandria's Assessment Office on each property's Real Property
26	Tax Statement, and which shall exclude all residential properties and residential portions of
27	mixed use properties.
28	
29	Section 2. The purposes of the Old Town BID are to promote the competitive success
30	of the commercial district of Old Town by providing services and facilities above and beyond
31 32	what is currently provided by the City government that enhance the economic activities and financial success of the businesses and commercial success located in the service district. The
32 33	financial success of the businesses and commercial properties located in the service district. The services and facilities provided in the Old Town BID are those authorized by law that facilitate
33 34	the aforesaid purposes including, but not limited to, promotion of businesses, branding and
35	marketing, sponsorship and promotion of recreational and cultural events, signage (e.g., banners,
36	wayfinding), beautification and landscaping, street and sidewalk cleaning, snow removal,
37	transportation and parking management services, and transportation related enhancements (e.g.,
38	bike racks).
39	
40	Section 3. The plan for providing enhanced facilities and services, above and beyond
41	what is currently and will be continually provided by the City of Alexandria government, within
42	the Old Town BID is for the City Manager to contract with a nonprofit corporation which shall
43	be responsible for the provision of specific services and facilities within the Old Town BID
44	identified in an annual work plan subject to annual approval and funding by the City Council.
45	

1 Section 4. The benefits to be expected from the creation of the Old Town BID include 2 economic development within the Old Town BID, competitive commercial success of existing 3 and future commercial properties, increased employment, and generally the preservation and 4 enhancement of the Old Town BID as a safe, secure, and attractive area in which businesses and 5 the community generally can thrive through the provision of additional, more complete and more 6 timely governmental services.

8 Section 5. This Ordinance does not levy a tax, however should a nonprofit 9 corporation as described in Section 3 request funding, the maximum tax rate shall be no greater 10 than \$0.10 on each \$100 of the assessed value of the commercial property or the commercial 11 portion of the property.

Section 6. This Ordinance and the Old Town BID established hereby shall be
effective as of January 1, 2018 and shall remain in effect until December 31, 2022.
